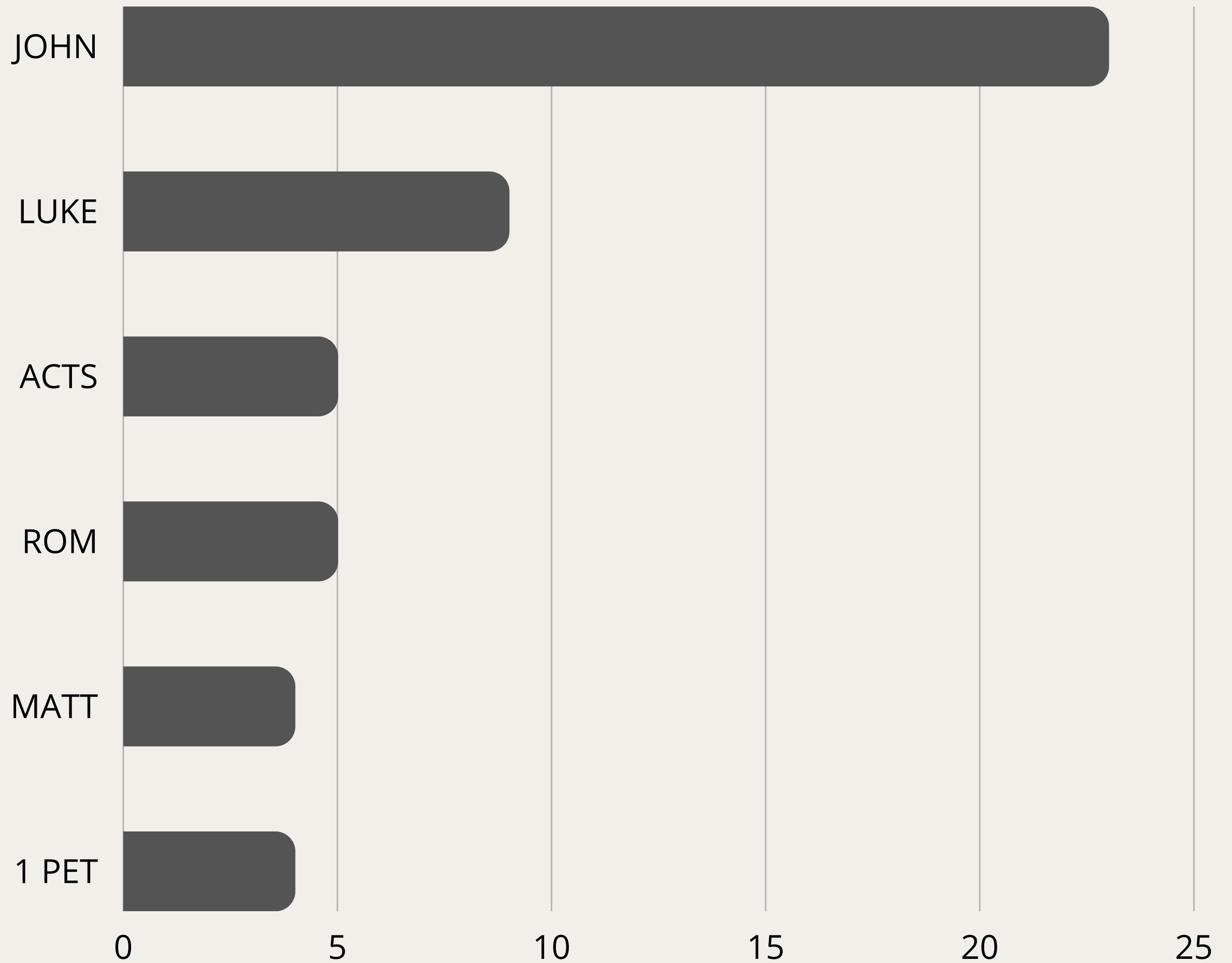

GLORY IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

1. **FIRST MANIFESTATION** (EXOD 16)
2. **MOUNT SINAI** (EXOD 24)
3. **TABERNACLE** (EXOD 40)
4. **TEMPLE** (2 CHRON 5)

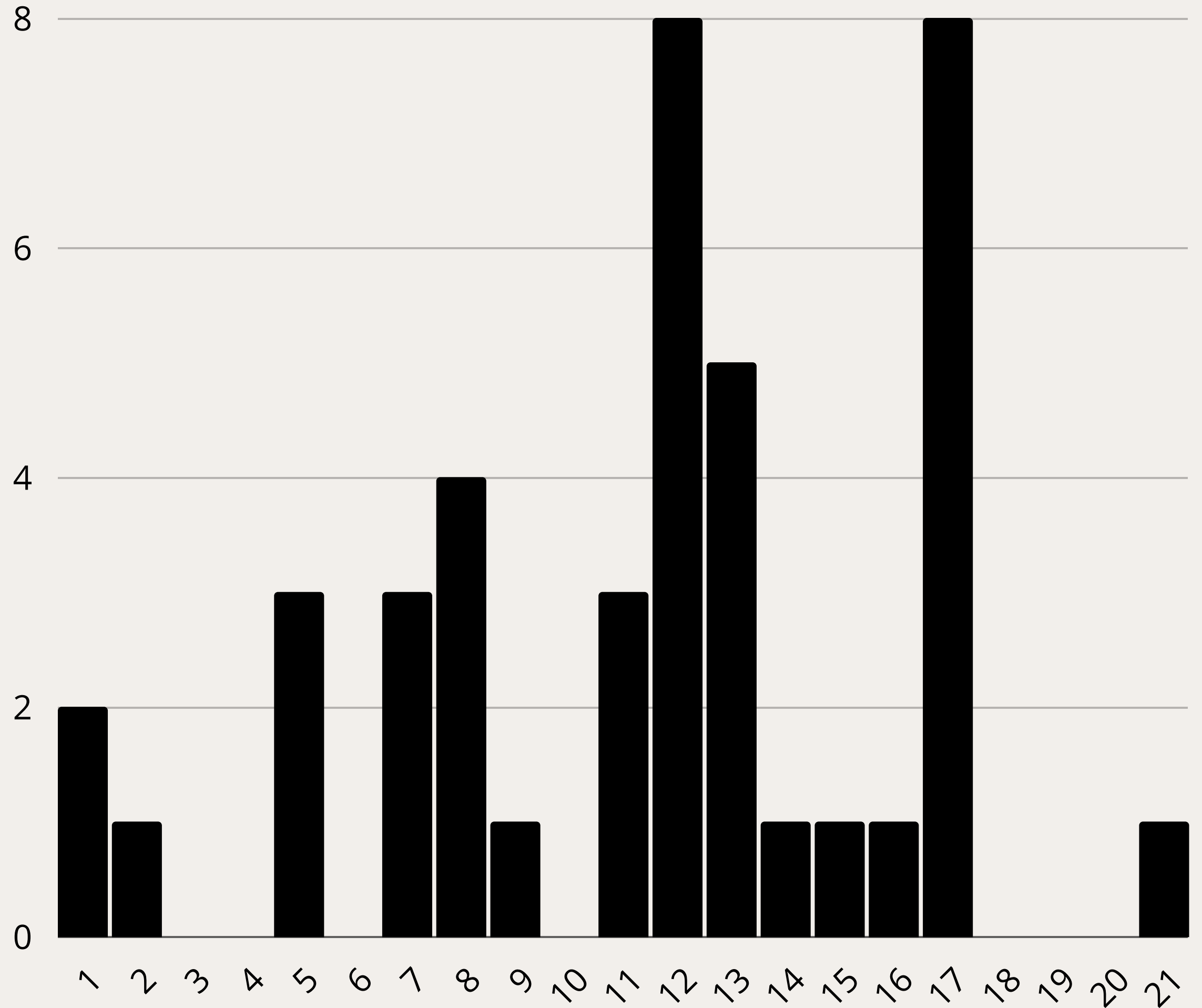
