





What do we notice?

Glory of the LORD is <u>veiled</u> by the cloud.

Moses said, "Please show me your glory." And he said, "I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name 'The LORD." ... "But," he said, "you cannot see my face, for man...

shall not see me and live." And the LORD said, "Behold, there is a place by me where you shall stand on the rock, and while my glory passes by I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and I will cover you with my...

hand until I have passed by. Then I will take away my hand, and you shall see my back, but my face shall not be seen."


