# What is Pentecost?

## Significance Then

- Feast that took place 50 days after the Passover.
- Purpose: celebration to thank God for the harvest-physical provision.

**\*God is fulfilling the scriptures**

**Right before these Believers eyes!**

## Significance Now

- Event that took place 50 days after Resurrection.
- Purpose: gathering with expectation b/c of Christ's-spiritual provision. The Holy Spirit arrives and indwells every Believer present.

The Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

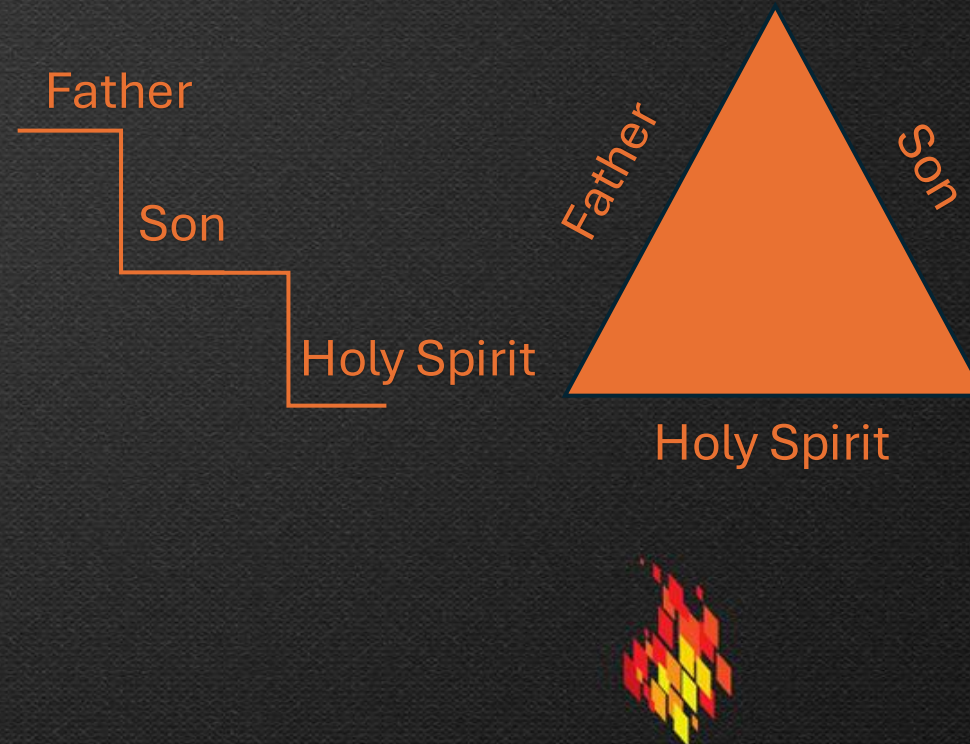

- The Holy Spirit is God
- Empowers Us 4 Greater Experiences
- Empowers Us to Evangelize
- Holy Boldness
- The Spirit of God w/in Us
- Our Teacher, Guide
- Indwells & Fills Us

# Empowerment for a New Experience
