Read Acts 9:10-20

This is the story immediately following Saul's/Paul's conversion. The Lord asks one of His followers to go to this person who only pages before was privy to the stoning of Stephen and was threatening other followers. Clearly you can understand Ananias' hesitation to help this person.

:: Share a time where you were prompted to speak to a person about the good news of Jesus Christ, but you didn't.

:: Explore and Discuss

Question: What was the reason for your hesitation?

Question: Why do you think so many Christians in this country are not sharing their faith with others?

Question: What do you suppose would have happened if Ananias had refused to go find Paul/Saul

:: Apply it to Your Life

Question: Sometimes our hesitation comes from wanting to be sure God is prompting us to witness. What are some things we can do to help us be sure?

Question: How can we be more effective in our disciple making efforts?

:: Pray

Father God, Lord Jesus, Holy Spirit, help us to be in your presence more regularly. And as we seek you more, may we know your will more for each of our lives and for the life of this, your church. Lord, open our eyes to see others as you see them and to share our walks with them in a way that reinforces what you are doing in their lives as well. Give us your words to speak that they may know your love for their lives. And may our Journeys continue on the Way of Grace toward you. We pray this in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Amen.
