:: Explore and Discuss

Question: In Matthew, Jesus said "*Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.*"
How might being successful become an impediment to receiving Salvation?

Question: Paul makes the argument that there is nothing we can do to achieve salvation (short of perfectly following the Law and its 600 plus rules given by God to Moses). Salvation is only a gift from God...through belief. How do you think some feel about this in our society?

:: Apply it to Your Life

Question: According to Paul here in Romans, is it enough to believe in your heart and live a Christian life?

Question: What do you suppose Paul means when he says we must confess it with our lips to be saved? Is this a once and done?

:: Pray:

Lord, forgive us the times we have not confessed you as Lord of our lives. Lord we believe, but help our unbelief and grow us daily to the point we not only confess you with our lips, but our lives reflect that confession. For it is for the Father's glory we pray this in our Savior's name. Amen
