



Recently while praying for the salvation of men in prison, the Holy Spirit surprised me with the following statement, "NO ONE GOES TO HELL BY ACCIDENT." As I pondered these poignant words, the Lord suddenly showed me a short film clip vision further illuminating the statement. A man was walking hastily to an appointment. He had papers in one arm and a cup of coffee in the other, rushing down the road of life, not paying attention to what was in front of him. Without warning, the man tripped over Jesus who was in the center of the road on his knees, praying and interceding in this man's behalf. The papers flew everywhere, the coffee spilled, and the man crashed to the ground disheveled. As he looked back from the ground, he saw the cause of his problem, but didn't recognize Jesus, who caused him to stumble. Instead, he became angry with the man. He looked upon Jesus with disdain, got up, dusted himself off, picked up his belongings, kicked dust in the face of Jesus, spat on him, and rushed off about his daily activities. The Holy Spirit then repeated the statement, "NO ONE GOES TO HELL BY ACCIDENT."

I began to realize that, throughout our lives, whether in prison or free, God places Jesus in our paths to keep us from going to hell. I began to reflect on the various times before going to prison that God tripped me up my way to destruction. My car failing in route to an appointment (an appointment which I later discovered to be a set up, and my car's strange malfunction saved me from getting busted). A troubling dream that later turned out to be an accurate warning to avoid certain conduct. A Christian handing out tracts in the bar district one night when I was out drinking it up. Each time, I spurned Jesus in my path. I did not recognize that it was Him who was delaying me on my way to eventual destruction. I remember speaking with disdain to those two young Christians handing out Bible tracts, telling them what they really needed was a

drink instead of Jesus. I scoffed at their remarks about how much Jesus loved me and that He wanted to save me from my path to hell and destruction. "Hell!" I thought. "If there really is such a place, then all my friends will be there!" I turned on my heels and kicked up dust as I headed into the door of one of the bars to get another drink with the crowd. I did not know, at the time, that my lifestyle truly was the path to my destruction.

Several situations and events occurred over the next few years. I constantly tripped over Jesus, who continued to get in my path. A phone call from a Christian on my answering machine, "I just want you to know that for the last two weeks the Lord has laid you upon my heart heavily and I'm praying for you." "That's strange," I thought. "I haven't heard from that person in more than two years. Not since college, when she invited me to a party, that turned out to be non-alcoholic and full of people that seemed to be having all kinds of fun sober. Oh yeah, they were Christians. Aaaaaah, that's for them. I've got my own life, and starting to do pretty good at it, too." Again, I did not recognize Jesus in my path. My Mother invited me to Church for Easter Sunday (several months in advance). I thought, "Oh, she'll forget about it by the time Easter rolls around," so I agreed to show up. The night before Easter Sunday, I heard my Mother's voice on my answering machine, reminding me of the date. She had raised me to be a man of my word. Therefore, I drove from the "big city" to a small hick town about 90 minutes away, and showed up late for the service, successfully avoiding the music portion. I snuck in the back row of the small church of about 35 people, where the sermon had already began.

I barely sat down when the preacher stopped his

Easter message and called me out by name! Then, he began prophesying over me to return to the call of God on my life. He told me things that he couldn't naturally know about my present lifestyle. None of it was condemning, but all of it was very convicting! It made me shake on the inside! Then, he reminded me of the love of Jesus and told me to get off the path I was on or it would lead to destruction. He returned to his sermon. I didn't hear anything else he preached that day. His words continued to resound in my spirit as I sat in the pew and pondered them. Finally, the closing hymn was being sung. I knew this was my cue to "cut out of Church" early, as I had in my early teen years when my parents required my Church attendance. While walking across the street to my car, I noticed a little old lady in a long dress and tennis shoes coming towards me, running as fast as she could. "Oh, no," I thought, "I gotta get out of here!" I picked up my pace, hoping to beat her to my car and get out of there! She somehow beat me to my car before I could get my hand on the door. Somewhat out of breath, she smiled and said, "My, what a nice prophecy the Pastor spoke over your life today. I've been attending church here for the better part of my 79 years and I've never been privileged to experience such a thing like that." I looked at her and thought, "Well, lady, if you were in as much sin as I am, he'd probably speak to you from the pulpit, too." Instead, I just smiled. She invited me to the Easter luncheon being held immediately after the service. I politely declined. Then she invited me back to Church the following Sunday. I told her that it was quite a long drive to come all the way out to this country congregation, but that I would probably begin attending a church near my home. I was lying. All the time, I was trying to get in my car. Finally, I was in. She was speaking to me through the window now. I tried to start my car. All the ignition would do was "click." The

engine wouldn't even turn over! She said, "Oh dear, car troubles?" I replied, "No, it does this sometimes." I was lying again, of course. My car had never once done this. I told her that everything would be okay. She smiled and told me that she'd be praying for me, then turned and walked off in that long dress and tennis shoes.

As I sat in my car, I said one of the few prayers uttered during my wayward years of sin. "God, I know I'm in sin. I know I need to get right with you. I promise that if you'll help get my car started, I'll begin going to Church." I turned the ignition, and "Vroom!" Instantly the car turned over. I sat there stunned. I knew it was God's hand at work. I put the vehicle in drive and pulled from the parking lot. The further I got from the Church, those Church people, and that church experience, the more the conviction began to fade. My acknowledgement of God's Hand began to lift. My promise to God also began to wane. My pager went off. I looked at the number. It was a drug transaction! I looked at the pager several times over the next few minutes. Should I return this call or not? A drug deal on Sunday? I'd made them before, why would it matter today? Besides, sin is sin, regardless of the day of the week one commits it. God doesn't group things into Friday night sins versus Tuesday morning sins. Therefore, I can't be penalized any more for sinning on Sunday after church than on Monday morning. There! It made sense. I'll call back and take care of this business right away and make some fast money! No reason to put this one off until a less holy day comes around. So, I did...

I never returned to Church. I stumbled across Jesus that day, but went about the business of my life, missing my day of visitation. No one goes to hell by accident! "Before every man there lies a wide and pleasant road that seems right but ends in death" (Proverbs 14:12, LVB).

"The faithless will be fully repaid for their ways" (Proverbs 14: 14, NIV). It would be three more years before I was finally arrested and sentenced to more than 20 years in Federal prison without parole. "Because God does not punish sinners instantly, people feel it is safe to do wrong" (Ecclesiastes 8:11, LVB). In retrospect, I honestly believe that my Mother's prayers protected me from arrest any earlier. She was a prayer warrior all those years. Finally, one day she told the Lord, "Father, I give my son to you. Do with him what you see best, but don't allow him to lose his life. Bring him to salvation." Twenty-four hours later, I was arrested. Go figure. Aaah, the power of a praying Christian. (I kind of wish she would have prayed that prayer a few years earlier. It could have saved me from a longer sentence.) We must reap what we sow in life (Galatians 6:7), and by now I had planted several fields full of sin. My harvest came in with interest. That was 1989. God did get my attention. In addition, he answered my Mother's prayer. I did come to salvation, and I didn't lose my life, just a lot of years of my freedom. I served 19 years, 6 months, a week and a day in prison.

A man in the county jail tried to encourage me with these sage words, "If you have to go to jail to avoid going to hell, it's worth it!" When I got to prison, another man told me something that stuck with me. "If you leave prison the same way you came in, you've failed jail, and you have to repeat the class." I looked around the prison and noticed most were second-, third-, fourth-, and fifth-time losers, some of them doing life without the possibility of parole. They would die in prison! No more chances, and they still hadn't repented. Their lives were effectively over. Without a miracle from God, many would never see freedom again. Still, they sat at the card tables gambling for stamps and commissary items, smoking cheap cigars, and drinking prison liquor (hooch) when they could find

it, or doing drugs when they could get up enough money to buy them. They were in and out of the prison's hole (solitary confinement) when caught and spent several months to a year each time for their conduct. During these "time outs," they tripped over Jesus in their path, the man praying for them in the middle of the road, trying to deter them from their roadway to destruction. "There is a way which seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death" (Proverbs 14:12, RSV). Jesus just keeps praying for us, even though we kick dust in His face, spit on Him, curse Him, and reject the counsel and advice of Christians He sends to speak into our lives. We allow the Bible He provides us to sit unread, on a shelf, display table or hidden in a drawer. "No one goes to hell by accident."

Television and sports activities are more important to us than God, His Word, Prayer, Church Fellowship. Social Media sites, our jobs, family and friends often take priority over God in our life. We can quote scores from around the sports league but can't quote three verses from the Bible. We can tell you the latest accomplishments and scandals with our NBA, NFL, or music and movie stars and starlets, but are unable to properly converse about God's heroes from the Bible. Who was Hezekiah anyway? Asa? Deborah, the prophetess? Did they ever have a hit CD? Ever score a touchdown? Win a Super Bowl? No, but they did stand in the paths of many who were on their way to destruction and turned them back to the path of life everlasting. They are heroes in God's eyes, and in the eyes of those men and women who they deterred from the pathway to hell.

WHAT IN HELL DO YOU WANT?

What in hell do you want? Don't you know that the party has been cancelled due to fire. There are no appeals courts there. No change of address labels at the post-of-fice. No exit signs. Eternity is set! "...man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment..." (Hebrews 9:27, NIV). There are no second chances in hell. What in hell do you want?

WHO IN HELL ARE YOU?

"And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth" for eternity (Matthew 25:30, NKJV, Matthew 8:12, Jude 1:13). Who are you in hell? Just another soul who didn't pay heed to all the warning signs. Not even the devil is running anything in hell. "He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil, or Satan, and bound him for a thousand years. He threw him into the Abyss, and locked and sealed it over him, to keep him from deceiving the nations anymore..." (Revelation 20:2, NIV). The devil's not running anything in hell. Neither are his servants. "But the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who had performed the miraculous signs on his behalf. With these signs he had deluded those who had received the mark of the beast and worshiped his image. The two of them were thrown alive into the fiery lake of burning sulfur" (Revelation 19:20, NIV). "...the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars their place will be in the fiery lake of burning sulfur..." (Revelation 21:8, NIV). The Bible tells us, "Blessed is the one who reads the words of this prophecy and blessed are

those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, because the time is near" (Revelation 1:3, NIV). So, who in hell will you be? Nobody, the same as everyone else who chose the low road and missed the gift of salvation Jesus offers.

DON'T GO TO HELL FOR ANYBODY

Men, don't go to hell for a woman. "But I love her!" Solomon warns us, "For a prostitute will bring a man to poverty, and an adulteress may cost him his very life" (Proverbs 6: 26, LVB). "...her speech is smoother than oil; but in the end she is bitter as gall, sharp as a double-edged sword. Her feet go down to death; her steps lead straight to the grave...Keep to a path far from her, do not go near the door of her house" (Proverbs 5: 3-8, NIV). Jezebel almost cost King Ahab his soul. Delilah cost Samson his eyes! Ladies, this applies to you as well! Take heed to the warnings God places in your path. Break off that unholy relationship with that man, or woman, today. Don't go to hell for any one!

DON'T GO TO HELL FOR YOUR FRIENDS

"But I want to fit in with the crowd!" Your friends may tell you, "Eat, drink, and be merry for tomorrow you die." In other words, "Hey, you only live once, enjoy life to the fullest. If it feels good, do it!" The Bible tells us, "It is appointed for man to die once, and then face the judgment" (Hebrews 9:27). Many people end up in hell because they wouldn't break unholy ties with their friends, their gang, their right-hand man, their drug and drinking buddies, club compatriots, false religion pals. They just wanted to

be accepted by the crowd. In hell, there are no more parties. Domino's pizza doesn't deliver. "...Here will be wailing and grinding of teeth" (Mathew 8:1; Luke 13:28, NAB). If you are in prison and reading this, maybe your good friends helped you get to the slammer. Have they sent you any money, or helped out your family, or even written you a letter? Good friends, huh? Having fun yet? People in hell aren't either. If you don't like prison, then you really won't like hell. Don't fail jail! If you come out the way you went in, you failed jail and will have to repeat the class. Tuition may run out, and then there's hell to pay! There's no commissary in hell, and no TV, radio or NFL games to keep you from Church on Sundays. The MTV or Rap videos to pollute your mind with your old lifestyle are no longer pumped into your mind; no more distractions to keep you from God's salvation. Only one problem – it's too late. Eternity is set and your friends are too busy crying like banshees and grinding their teeth to have fun with you anymore, wishing they'd recognized Jesus in their paths instead of spurning him with their word and spitting on him with their repeated actions.

DON'T GO TO HELL FOR ANYTHING

"Stop loving this evil world and all that it offers you, for when you love these things you show that you do not really love God; for all these worldly things, these evil desires—the craze for sex, the ambition to buy everything that appeals to you, and the pride that comes from wealth and importance—these are not from God. They are from this evil world itself. And this world is fading away, and these evil, forbidden things will go with it, but whoever keeps doing the will of God will live forever" (1John 2:15–17, LVB). "But I have to make money to live!" Jesus will provide, through an honest living, one you can be proud

of and honors him, others and adds to the betterment of the community. "But I don't have a skill set!" you say. Be at rest, you will. In the meantime, He clothes the lilies of the field and He can certainly take care of you (see Matthew 6:25-33). Begin by "seeking first the kingdom of God and his righteousness and all these things will be added unto you..." (Matthew 6:33). Don't end up in hell for anything. "And how do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul in the process? Is anything worth more than your soul?" (Matthew 16:26, NLT). Jesus is in your path today; will you curse Him or embrace Him? Do not let the things of this world distract you. Don't fail life! There are no repeats. "It's appointed for man to die once, and then face judgment" (Hebrews 9:27). Don't go to hell for anything.

TWO ROADS

There are two roads in life, the narrow road and the wide road. "Heaven can be entered only through the narrow gate! The highway to hell is broad, and its gate is wide enough for all the multitudes who choose its easy way. But the Gateway to Life is small, and the road is narrow, and only a few ever find it" (Matthew 7:13-14, LVB). All our friends from the world are on the wide road. "If it feels good, do it!" is the motto on the wide road. "You are the captain of your own soul" people on this road will tell you. What they don't ever mention is where the road leads. Hell is too hot to spend eternity in. Jesus told a parable about a rich man that spent his entire life on the wide road. The road, at death, led to hell.

"Finally, the beggar died and was carried by the angels to be with Abraham in the place of the righteous dead. The rich man also died and was buried, and his soul went

into hell. There, in torment, he saw Lazarus in the far distance with Abraham. 'Father Abraham,' he shouted, 'have some pity! Send Lazarus over here if only to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am in anguish in these flames.' But Abraham said to him, 'Son, remember that during your lifetime you had everything you wanted, and Lazarus had nothing. So now he is here being comforted and you are in anguish. And besides, there is a great chasm separating us, and anyone wanting to come to you from here is stopped at its edge; and no one over there can cross to us.' Then the rich man said, 'O Father Abraham, then please send him to my father's home – for I have five brothers – to warn them about this place of torment lest they come here when they die.' But Abraham said, 'The Scriptures have warned them again and again. Your brothers can read them any time they want to.' The rich man replied, 'No, Father Abraham, they won't bother to read them. But if someone is sent to them from the dead, then they will turn from their sins.' But Abraham said, 'If they won't listen to Moses and the prophets, they won't listen even though someone rises from the dead" (Luke 16:22-31, LVB).

WHAT ROAD ARE YOU ON?

Are you on the wide road or the narrow road? Are you headed for heaven or hell? "Jesus said: I am the Way; I am Truth and Life. No one can come to the Father except through me" (John 14:6, NJB). Jesus is the doorway to the narrow road that leads to everlasting life. "I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he shall be saved" (John 10:9, NAS). Jesus was raised from the dead for you and me. Will you believe? Will you receive Him as your Lord and Savior? Jesus is in your path again today. Will you respond to his voice?

HELL WASN'T MADE FOR YOU OR ME

God never intended hell for you or me. He made "for the devil and his angels" (2Peter 2:4; Revelation. 19:20-21; 20:1-3). In fact, hell doesn't even have room for you and me. For this reason, hell has to actually "enlarge itself" to make accommodations for the newcomers. ". .. but they regard not the work of the Lord, neither consider the operation of his hands... therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure; and their glory, and their multitude [of men] and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it" (Isaiah 5:12-14, KJV). On the other hand, God made Heaven for you and me. Jesus declared, "In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there you may be also" (John 14:2-3, KJV). Where do you want to end up - Heaven or hell? The choice is solely yours; Heaven's Holy Hilton or hell's Motley Motel 666?

PRAYER OF REPENTANCE

Jesus, I see you are the doorway to salvation. I have been on the wide road for too many years. Today I am ready to change. I want you to take charge as Captain of my soul. I am sorry for my sins. I repent. I turn from my wicked ways. I choose you as Lord and Savior. Thank you for dying on the Cross for me and raising back to life on the third day. I believe. I receive you into my heart right now. Cleanse me from all my sin and unbelief. Give me a thirst and hunger to read the Bible. Fill me with the knowledge of your will so I may serve you the remaining days of my life; then

spend eternity in Heaven with the real heroes of life – God's children. Today, I choose life and enter the narrow road through Jesus Christ. Amen.

FINAL WORD

Now that you are born again (John 3:3), and have become "a new creation in Christ" (2Corinthians 5:17-18), God has "given you a new heart, and put a new spirit within you" (Ezekiel 36:25-26). He will now cause you, from the new nature within you, to be able to begin keeping his commands and ways. Your desires will change. Walking on the narrow path will be easier than you ever thought possible. Just keep looking for Jesus to lead you. If you ever find yourself feeling lost again, simply call out to Jesus and he will show up. It may be through another Christian. A verse of Scripture may come to mind, giving you wisdom. Or, suddenly power will come upon you to overcome the situation before you. The power to overcome temptation always comes before you are tempted, not during or after. Use the power He gives you to say "No" and walk away. Go to church. Fellowship with other Believers. Read your Bible. If you don't have one, get one. Ask God to provide one. God has wonderful plans for you from this day forward. In fact, God will even turn your past mistakes into something good over time. He will cause your family members to give you another chance. He will begin reconciling your family, or even give you a new one. This is one of the things He loves to do for his children. The devil may have meant it for harm, but God turns everything for good, and for the saving of others from destruction (Gen. 50:19-20/ Rom. 8:28). You have become one of Heaven's heroes. And it's no accident you are going to Heaven! Jesus and His many angels have been in your path for years! Congratulations! Welcome to the family of God. Angels are rejoicing in Heaven as we speak (Luke 15:10)! Rejoice with Heaven. You are a child of God!

A lake of fire (Revelation 20:15)

A bottomless pit (Revelation 20:1)

A horrible tempest (Psalms 11:6)

A devouring fire (Isaiah 33:14

A place of sorrows (Psalms 18:5)

A place of weeping (Matthew 8:12)

A place of torments (Matthew 13:41-42)

A place of everlasting burnings (Isaiah 33:14)

A place they gnaw their tongues (Revelation 16:10)

A place of extreme thirst with no water (Luke 16:24)

A place where people pray with no answers (Luke 16:27)

A place prepared for the devil and his angels (Matthew 25:41)

A place where they cannot die, but wish they could (Mark 9:48)

A place where they do not want their loved ones to come (Luke 16:28)

The first word out of the mouth of Jesus was "repent" (Matthew 4:17). There are 46 verses where He spoke about hell, and 18 of those verses were about the fires of hell. He also said, "Woe unto you, scribes, Pharisees, hypocrites...for ye are like unto whited sepulchers...full of dead men's bones...ye snakes, vipers...full of extortion... How can you escape the damnation of hell?" (Matthew

23:13-35) He said, "those mine enemies, bring hither, and slay them before me (Luke 19:27). But to you he says, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰ For my yoke is easy and my burden is light" (Matthew 11:28-30, NIV).

The Bible records 250 verses on hell, a sufficient amount of warnings from God so no one will end up there. God's will is that none perish, but *ALL* come to repentance (2Peter 3:9). 75% of the population believes in hell (750 out of 1000), but less than .5% (one-half of one percent, or 5 out of 1000) believes they will end up there. Jesus said, "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. ¹⁴ But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it. (Matthew 7:13-14). Said another way, Jesus indicates that MANY are going to hell, which sounds like a whole lot more than 5 out of 1000. Trust Jesus' statistics and be one of the few by trusting Jesus today!

God never made hell for humans, only for the devil and his angels (Matthew 25:41). Jesus died a horrible death on the Cross in our place so we can enjoy heaven with him for eternity. He says, "Behold, I stand at the door (of your hearts) and knock, if any man invites me in we will have a table of reconciliation and peace together" (Revelation 3:20).

Hell defined:

Hell is simply 100% separation from God. 100% separation from the God people reject all their lives. Hell is100%

separation from everything God is, His love, His Goodness, His nature, His attributes.

All the good we experience in life comes down from God, the Father of Lights (James 1:17). All the evil we experience comes from a fallen world and Satan, who originally rejected God and was cast out of Heaven. A third of the angels rejected God and aligned themselves with Satan and were cast out with him. They now dwell on the earth deceiving mankind because of his hatred toward God (See Luke 10:18; Revelation 12:9-11). Don't be deceived, in Hell there is no goodness, no God, only the absence of everything that God is. A dark room is dark because of the absence of light. A cold room is cold because of the absence of heat.

Attributes of Hell:

- *There is only darkness in Hell because 1John 1:5 says, "God is light."
- *There is only death in hell because John 1:4 says, "God is life."
- *There is only hatred in hell because 1John 4:16 says, "God is love."
- *There is no mercy in hell because Psalms 36:5 says, "The mercy of the Lord is in the heavens."
- *There is no strength in hell because Psalms 18:32 says, "It's the Lord that gives us strength."
- *There is no water in hell because Deuteronomy 11:11 says, "Water is the rain of heaven."
- *There is no peace in hell because Isaiah 9:6 says, "He is the Prince of Peace."

Jesus says, "This is the will of the Father who sent Me,

that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing but should raise it up at the last day. ⁴⁰ "And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day" (John 6:37-40, NIV).

Tell everyone about the good news, Jesus is waiting with open arms today!

How to Accept Jesus - Sinner's Prayer.

"Heavenly Father, I come to You as I am in need of a Savior. Today I turn from my sins and turn to Jesus. I believe He died on the Cross, was buried in the tomb, and on the third day He was supernaturally raised from the dead.

Jesus, cleanse me with Your shed blood, make me clean, and heal my wounded soul. I break all ties with Satan, his influences, all negative and evil people, and demons. Jesus, I ask you now to remove sins and demonic strongholds. I fully give You my life, and I fully receive Yours into my spirit, soul, and body in Jesus' Name. Holy Spirit, I invite You to come in and take full residence in my heart. Amen."

Prayer for Holy Spirit Baptism

"Heavenly Father, I thank You for the gifts You have freely given to me so I can walk in Your love and power. You said in Luke 11:13, "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!" Based upon Your Word, I ask You from my heart for the Holy Spirit baptism of fire, power and love now in Jesus' mighty Name.

I repent of anything I have been in agreement with against

this gift. I also ask You to give me my personal prayer language of tongues, so I can pray to You in secret and see Your power released in, through and around me in public. By faith now, I fully expect to experience this empowerment for service from You and I fully expect to speak in other tongues now in Jesus' Name. Amen."

Now spend a few minutes with the Lord. If you can, just lift your hands in the air like a child reaching up to his Heavenly Father and allow the Holy Spirit to fill you afresh.

A new prayer language will often come up from your belly and begin to bubble forth through your lips and mouth when you do this. This language may also come while you lie down and pray like it did with me years ago. If you allow the Holy Spirit to have freedom with your mouth in the same way you allowed the enemy in days gone by, your whole life and the atmosphere around you will be transformed as Heaven fills you. Go ahead, take some time alone with the Lord.

How to Receive the Holy Spirit's Empowerment for Ministry

Heavenly Father, you said that we could be baptized with the Holy Spirit and FIRE. Based on your promises, I want everything that you have for me. I desire to be baptized with the Holy Spirit fire empowerment that will burn up everything inside me that will hinder me in my walk with Christ or your people. So I ask you now in faith to "Fill me with the Holy Spirit and FIRE! I receive now." Spend a few minutes with the Lord as He visits you.

Prayer for Deliverance from Deferred Hope

"Lord, I recognize my need for deliverance from deferred hope. I ask You now in the Name of Jesus to set me free from every stronghold of the enemy in my life. I humbly yet boldly ask for complete deliverance from the enemy's mindset, spiritual forces, and words that have been spoken into my life.

I believe Your promises concerning my life and will accept no compromise. I want all You have for me. Father, show me Your faithfulness in some way today, and in the days ahead, so that I might know You are with me. I thank You for a fresh injection of hope right now, in Jesus' Mighty Name. Amen."

Now, let me pray for you, just as that dear saintly woman calmly prayed for me when I was in Leavenworth, nearing the end of my sentence:

"Deferred hope, I name you and break you off of this life right now in Jesus' Name. I command you to depart from them and never return. In its place, I release a desire fulfilled from the Lord right now over your life, which the Bible says is like a tree of life. I speak the shed blood of Jesus Christ between you and the adversary of your soul, and I release a blessing of perseverance upon you now.

By the authority of Jesus' Name, I release renewed vision and the mind of Christ to fill your mind now. I speak full restoration of hope to your soul from this point forward. Amen."

Prayer for Your Loved One's Salvation

"Lord Jesus, You are the g	reat Liberator. You set the cap-
tives free. I believe that (_	name of your loved

one) will come to know You personally. I come against the attempts of hell to derail Your call upon their life. Lord, I ask You to speak to _____ in dreams in the night. Visit him/her with Your tangible Presence and love. Send others to speak Your words of life into his/her heart. Convict _____ of sin during the day and draw them to You in the late hours of the night. Even when he/she shows no sign of change, even when _____ speaks words that cause me to doubt, I will hold fast to Your promises by faith in your Word. I believe You are working in him/her, despite anything said and/or what I see. Apprehend and captivate _____ with Your love, Father. Let be a living miracle, a testimony of Your power to transform a life. Thank You for the miracle that is about to happen with ______. I believe that nothing is impossible with You. I pray this prayer and proclamation in the all-powerful Name of Jesus. Amen."

Daily Prayer Covering for You and Your House

I found this prayer in the 1990's. Although I'm not a big fan of pre-written prayers but I've shared this one for 25 years. There's something about it that seems to fire up my inner spirit man EVERY time I pray it out loud. The author is unknown; maybe the Holy Spirit wanted it this way.

I use it as a jump start in the morning to help get into God's Presence. When I come across a word in the prayer that ignites my spirit, I leave the written prayer, and allow the Holy Spirit to lead me with Heaven's specific words for the day. This could go on for a few seconds, minutes, or even longer as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Be encouraged to pray this **out loud** daily for thirty days and see how your prayer life and spiritual walk with Jesus is transformed. Watch what the Holy Spirit does once you are sparked and His engine of prayer within you takes over.

Daily Prayer Covering for You and Your House

"Heavenly Father, I pray this prayer in the power of the Holy Spirit. In the Name of Jesus Christ I bind, rebuke, and bring to no effect all division, discord, disunity, strife, anger, wrath, murder, criticism, condemnation, pride, jealousy, gossip, slander, envy, evil speaking, complaining, lying, false teaching, false gifts, false manifestations, lying signs and wonders, poverty, fear of lack, fear spirits, murmuring spirits, complaining spirits, hindering spirits, retaliatory spirits, deceiving spirits, religious spirits, occult spirits, witchcraft spirits (including Jezebel, Delilah, and Apollyon), and spirits of the Antichrist.

I bind all curses that have been spoken against me. I bless those who curse me and pray blessings on those who despitefully use me. I bind all spoken judgments made against me, and judgments I have made against others. I bind the power of negative words from others, and I bind and render useless all prayers not inspired by the Holy Spirit; whether psychic, soul force, witchcraft, or counterfeit tongues that have been prayed against me.

I am Your child. I resist the devil. No weapon formed against me shall prosper. I put on the whole armor of God. I take authority over this day, in Your Name, Jesus. Let it be prosperous for me. Let me walk in Your love, Lord.

The Holy Spirit leads and guides me today. I discern between the righteous and the wicked. I take authority over Satan and all his demons, and those people who are influenced by them. I declare Satan is under my feet and shall remain there all day. I am the righteousness of God in

Christ Jesus. I am God's property. Satan, you are bound from my family, my mind, my body, my home, and my finances. I confess that I am healed and whole. I flourish, am long-lived, stable, durable, incorruptible, fruitful, virtuous, and full of peace, patience and love. Whatsoever I set my hands to do shall prosper, for God supplies all my needs. I have all authority over Satan, all demons, and beasts of the field.

God, I pray for the ministry You have for me. Anoint me for all You have called me to do for You. I call forth divine appointments, open doors of opportunity, God-ordained encounters, and ministry positions.

I claim a hedge of protection around myself, my spouse and my children (_______insert names) throughout this day and night. I ask You, God, in the Name of Jesus, to dispatch angels to surround me, my spouse, and my children today. Put them throughout my house and around our cars, souls and bodies. I invoke angels to protect my house from any intrusion and to protect my family and me from any harmful demonic or other physical or mental attacks. I ask this prayer in the Name of Jesus. Amen."





























"No one goes to hell by accident!" were the words I heard as the vision opened before me.
