## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Paul says, "None of these things move me" (Acts 20:24). What are some things that tend to "move" or unsettle you in your faith journey? How can we cultivate Paul's attitude?
  2. The sermon mentions the difference between opinions and convictions. How would you define each, and why is it important to live by convictions rather than opinions?
  3. Pastor Nathan talks about the "fear of God" being both knee-trembling and knee-bowing. How do you understand this concept, and how does it impact your daily life?
  4. The sermon emphasizes the importance of having a strong foundation in God's Word. What practical steps can we take to build and maintain this foundation?
  5. How does Paul's example of leadership and service challenge our modern understanding of Christian leadership?
  6. The pastor mentions looking at the future with "curiosity and wonder" rather than fear. How can we cultivate this perspective in our lives?
