# 1. Title

- Be creative!

- “Men Who Bear Children!”
- “The Art of Giant Killing”
- “The Capital City of Heaven”
- “Can A Man Fly?”

# 2. Introduction

- Give a “Teaser”

- ◆ *Raising interest in what is coming*

- Intercession – Labor pains in prayer

- Overcoming insurmountable odds

- The reality of the afterlife

- Taking a Leap of Faith

# 3. State Your Objective

## ■ Your Main Idea

- ◆ *“I want to talk to you about...”*

## ■ Target

- If you aim at something, you might even hit it!



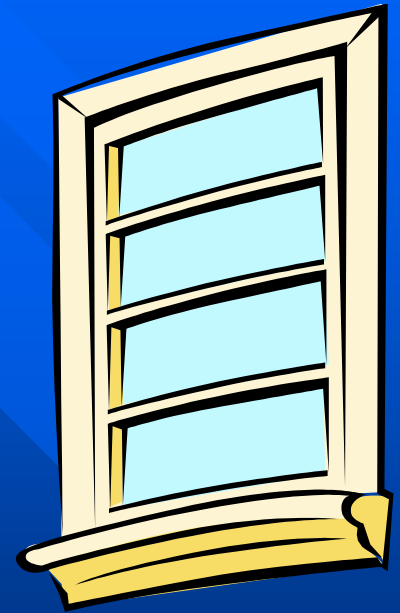
# 4. Enumerate Your Points

- Where are you are headed?
- Keep Their Attention!
  - More important than getting all the points in.



# 5. Heart of Message

- Good illustration
  - Windows of message
- Common experiences of life
  - People can identify
- Personal experience; story
  - What you learned from it
- Practical application



# 6. Conclusion:

- Wrap up your points
  - Repeat them quickly
- Make it personal to the listener
  - So they can identify with points
- Practical application
  - What do you want to see in response?

# 7. Invitation and Prayer

- Refer back to points
  - Drive home conviction!
- Take time with altar call
  - Call them several times
  - Many only come on the “last call”
- Final prayer
