Small Group Guide: Understanding Spiritual Gifts and Love

Key Takeaways:

- 1. Love is the highest priority for believers, even above spiritual gifts.
- 2. Speaking in tongues is communication from man to God, while prophecy is communication from God to man through a person.
- 3. In church settings, gifts that edify the whole body (like prophecy) are more beneficial than personal gifts (like tongues).
- 4. The proper use of spiritual gifts should always be for building up the church, not for personal glory.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How does Paul prioritize love in relation to spiritual gifts? Why do you think this is important?
- 2. What is the difference between speaking in tongues and prophecy according to the sermon? How does this impact their use in church settings?
- 3. Pastor Jerry mentioned that "we can experience God's love and we can extend God's love without having to be a Bible scholar." How does this statement encourage you in your faith journey?
- 4. The sermon emphasized that spiritual gifts are tools, not goals. How might this perspective change the way we view and pursue spiritual gifts?
- 5. How can we ensure that our use of spiritual gifts is focused on edifying others rather than drawing attention to ourselves?
- 6. Pastor Jerry mentioned Charlie Kirk's passing and other recent tragedies. How can we as believers respond to difficult events in a way that demonstrates God's love?

Practical Applications:

- 1. This week, focus on pursuing love as your highest priority. Keep a journal of ways you intentionally showed love to others.
- 2. Reflect on your own spiritual gifts. How can you use them to build up the church body rather than for personal edification?
- 3. Practice active listening when others are sharing their struggles or grief. Remember the importance of comforting others before trying to solve their problems.
- 4. If you're unfamiliar with or uncomfortable about certain spiritual gifts, commit to studying Scripture and reliable resources (like the recommended book "Charisma vs. Charismania" by Chuck Smith) to gain a better understanding.
- 5. In your daily prayers this week, ask God to help you grow in love and to use your gifts in a way that honors Him and benefits others.
