

Eliah Drinkwitz, head football coach at University of Missouri

Eliah Drinkwitz is the University of Missouri's 33rd head football coach and the 2023 Southeastern Conference (SEC) Coach of the Year. Drinkwitz is considered one of college football's top offensive minds. Under Drinkwitz's leadership, Mizzou has produced its highest-ranked recruiting classes including three straight Top 25 ranked classes. Drinkwitz and his 2023 Tigers team put together an 11-2 season that saw MU move into the Top 10 of all three national polls, qualifying for its first New Year's Six bowl and then defeating Ohio State in the Goodyear Cotton Bowl. Drinkwitz graduated magna cum laude and was the student body president at Arkansas Tech before beginning his coaching career in 2005. He and his wife, Lindsey, have four daughters.

Dr. Chris Harper, CEO of BetterMan

As the Chief Storyteller and CEO of BetterMan, Inc., Chris "Harp" Harper has helped to equip more than 300,000 men and more than 3,000 churches to the life-giving manhood of King Jesus. Harp believes hospitality is the new evangelism and that art, music, commerce, and education are the most powerful mediums for gospel witness today. He makes an encore return to our 2024 conference based on the response to his inaugural appearance during our 2023 conference. Harp holds a Doctorate from the Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and a Master's Degree from Dallas Theological Seminary. He is convinced that the most critical need of the church today is men, bold men, willing to lead their homes and serve the church

Will Coleman, pastor of Chazown Church, St. Louis

As the Lead Pastor of Chazown Church in St. Louis, Will Coleman works fervently to guide and uplift men in their walk with Jesus. His commitment extends beyond the pulpit because of his belief that a community flourishes where faith and family intersect. Will is a graduate of Oral Roberts University and was previously a campus pastor for Life.Church. Will is a dedicated husband to Davina, his wife of 17 years, and a loving father to their three daughters.

Jett Brawley, co-founder of Encounter Ministries

Jeff Brawley is the co-founder of Encounter Ministry. His ministry hosts a series of events where God meets people where they are on their spiritual journey while promoting unity among a variety of faith communities. Since 2010 Encounter Ministry has reached over 70,000 individuals through the 48-hour Men's Encounter weekends, Ashes to Beauty weekends, and the I Still Do marriage weekend, as well as the Encounter Kids and youth camps. As a result, thousands of salvations, re-dedications, restored marriages, families reconnected, addictions abandoned, dope dealers turned to hope dealers. Jeff has a heart of compassion for the lost, hurting and broken as well as helping pastors reignite their fire to continue God's vision for ministry.

Jay Porter, pastor of Life.Church of Kansas City

Jay Porter has spent the last decade serving Life. Church under the leadership of Pastor Craig Groeschel. Today, Life. Church is known as one of the most innovative churches in America and the creator of the YouVersion Bible App. Jay helped launch the 33rd Life. Church location five years ago in Kansas City and continues to serve as its campus pastor. Jay has been happily married to his wife, Caley, for 16 years, and together, they have four children.

2024 Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes




