### Eliah Drinkwitz, head football coach at University of Missouri

Eliah Drinkwitz is the University of Missouri's 33rd head football coach and the 2023 Southeastern Conference (SEC) Coach of the Year. Drinkwitz is considered one of college football's top offensive minds. Under Drinkwitz's leadership, Mizzou has produced its highest-ranked recruiting classes including three

straight Top 25 ranked classes. Drinkwitz and his 2023 Tigers team out together an 11-2 season that saw MU move into the Top 10 of all three national polls, qualifying for its first New Year's Six bowl and then defeating Ohio State in the Goodyear Cotton Bowl. Drinkwitz graduated magna cum laude and was the student body president at Arkansas Tech before beginning his coaching career in 2005. He and his wife, Lindsey, have four daughters.

## 2024 Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes




