2. What does Romans 14:1-20 teach us about passing judgment on each other in the family of God?
3. What are some 'opinions' or 'disputable matters' (Romans 14:1) within modern church life that cause believers to 'quarrel' (14:1), 'despise' (14:3), and 'pass judgment' on one another (14:3)?
4. How should we treat one another according to Paul (Romans 14) and Jesus (Matthew. 7:1-5)? Where does grace come into play in our treatment of one another?
5. What does 1 Corinthians 5:1-13 teach us about judgment inside and outside the church?
6. How does Matthew 18:15-20 apply to what Paul had to say about the individual living in sin?
7. What is the process Jesus gives for dealing with a 'speck' in a believer's eye (Matthew 7:5)? Why does he use the 'eye' as his example?
8. What should our attitude be like towards those who come to TAC who are lost and have lifestyles we believe are sinful?
9. What needs to change inside of you if you have a critical, harsh, and judgmental heart towards others?
