“Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. ¹⁴For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few.”

Two Gates	Narrow Gate	Wide Gate
Two Roads	Hard Road	Easy Road
Two Destinations	Life	Destruction
Two Groups	Few	Many

1. GATE #1 (Matthew 7:13).

It is a “wide gate.”

It leads to an “easy road.”

It ends in “destruction.”

It is the gate of choice for “many.”
