Keys:

1. God promised to pour out His Spirit on all flesh in the last days. Joel 2
2. Jesus is our model. Jesus did all that He did in His earthly ministry by the supernatural power of the Holy Spirit.
3. The fulfillment of God's promise in Joel 2 and the dispensation of the Holy Spirit began with the birth of the Church in Acts 2 and continues with us today.
4. We believe that the Baptism, gifts and ministries of the Holy Spirit continue today and will continue to operate until the return of Christ according to the Word of God. Cessationist vs Continuationist view.
5. The Supernatural Gifts & Ministries of the Holy Spirit operating in the Church are absolutely essential to fulfilling the great commission and for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

The Word of God reveals Christianity as a supernatural way of life. To be functioning members of the body of Christ as well as more effective witnesses for Him in the world, we must have an understanding of the 9 supernatural gifts of the Holy Spirit and their operation in our lives.

realized through Jesus Christ. No one has seen God at any time; the only begotten God who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained Him.”

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord. There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all persons. But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit; to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of

tongues. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills. For even as the body is one and yet has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ. For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.”

The Grace of God - the greek word Charis:
God's unmerited favor and supernatural enablement and empowerment for salvation and for daily sanctification.

Charisma = The Grace Gifts

The 9 grace gifts of the Spirit listed:

1. A Word of Wisdom
2. A Word of Knowledge
3. Faith
4. Gifts of Healing
5. Working of Miracles
6. Prophecy
7. Discerning of Spirits
8. Various Kinds of Tongues
9. Interpretation of Tongues

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit can be organized in 3 groups of 3:

The Revelatory Gifts

1. A Word of Wisdom
2. A Word of Knowledge
3. Discernings of Spirits

The Power Gifts

1. Faith
2. Gifts of Healings
3. Workings of Miracles

The Inspirational Vocal Gifts

1. Various Kinds of Tongues
2. Interpretation of Tongues
3. Prophecy

There are two foundation stones that the gifts of the Holy Spirit are built upon in the church. These foundation stones are Unity and Love. We as one body, the body of Christ must function as one in unity and walk in love for the gifts of the Spirit to flow unhindered as the Holy Spirit desires. Where there is disunity and selfish motives the Holy Spirit will be grieved the gifts will not function.

All of the supernatural gifts of the Holy Spirit operate by Faith! We receive and activate these gifts Faith. Believing that God has given you supernatural gifts and abilities by the Holy Spirit for the common good of the whole body to

Romans 12:3-8 NASB1995

“For through the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith. For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith; if service, in his serving; or he who teaches, in his teaching; or he who exhorts, in his exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.”

“Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.

But one who prophesies speaks to men for edification and exhortation and consolation.

What is the outcome then, brethren? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification. The building up of the body in love!

For you can all prophesy one by one, so that all may learn and all may be exhorted; and the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets; for God is not a God of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.

Therefore, my brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak in tongues. But all things must be done properly and in an orderly manner.”

Ministry Gifts and Spiritual Gifts

With ministry gifts the person IS the gift to the body and with spiritual gifts the person HAS the gift for the body.

Ephesians 4:7-13 NASB1995

“But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ’s gift.

Therefore it says, "When He ascended on high, He led captive a host of captives, And He gave gifts to men." (Now this expression, "He ascended," what does it mean except that He also had descended into the lower parts of the earth? He who descended is Himself also He who ascended far above all the heavens, so that He might fill all things.)

And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ."
