


# "WE CAN DO HARD THINGS!"


There has been a whole lot of love and support coming from Paul, Timothy, and Epaphras to the church at Colossae. This morning, their faith walk is about to be put to the test. Just like today, they experienced a constant attack from the enemy aimed at disrupting, destroying, and killing the church. We will look at the four tactics that the enemy used and the three responses that Paul gives the church to stand strong.

While this is a difficult section of Scripture to study, understand, and apply, I believe that God is going to use this text TODAY to equip us for the enemy's attacks. There is a tongue in cheek statement that gets used a lot in our generation: "We can do hard things." I am praying that this will be true today. May the Lord help us grasp the truth of this text, and understand it so clearly that we can apply it to our lives immediately.

I highly encourage you to spend some time working through the reflection questions on the back of your sermon notes. Digging into this text is what our syllabus encourages us to do as we grow in knowledge and abound in thanksgiving. Fasto, Mark
