

"I must put them all away."

Last week was a hard message to preach. God laid out some very specific things that we should put to death in our lives. It seems like it would be a good idea to follow up that message with something light, encouraging, and joyful. Nope. That starts next week when we start looking at all of the things that should be a part of our life as a believer in Christ. This week, God continues to list some very specific things that need to go.

The work this week isn't to "put to death". This week, God tells us that we must put all these things away. Notice the imperative nature of that sentence. "We must" is not a suggestion. It is a timely command that seems rather focused on the "now", not on the "when I get around to it." Notice how the imperative is all inclusive: "We must put them all away." All of these things must go. And now. That is God's message for today.

As we look at these things that live in our heart and are lived out through our words and deeds, it should be a very sobering time of reflection. I am praying in that direction. This is the kind of Sunday that could change the trajectory of our church and our life, if we lean into the Spirit and let Him work.
