



Response to False Teaching

Go back and review the four goals of false teaching found in Colossians 2:4; 2:8; 2:16; 2:18.

All of these verses in Colossians speak to being "complete in Christ." What do they say?

Col. 1:27-28; Col. 2:1-3; Col. 2:9-10

How does **baptism** symbolize the spiritual transformation *(spiritual circumcision)* that we experience through Christ according to **Colossians** 2:11-12?

According to **Colossians 2:14**, what **specifically** did Christ do with **the record of debt** that stood against us?

Why **(how)** is **Colossians 2:15** important as part of Paul's **response** to false teaching?

How does 1 John 1:3-9 help explain why we confess our sins since He has already forgiven all of our trespasses according to Colossians 2:13? Hint: Key word is "fellowship".

What **specifically** does God do for the **"body"** according to **Colossians 2:19**?

Why do you think it was important for Paul to write "with a growth that is from God"?
