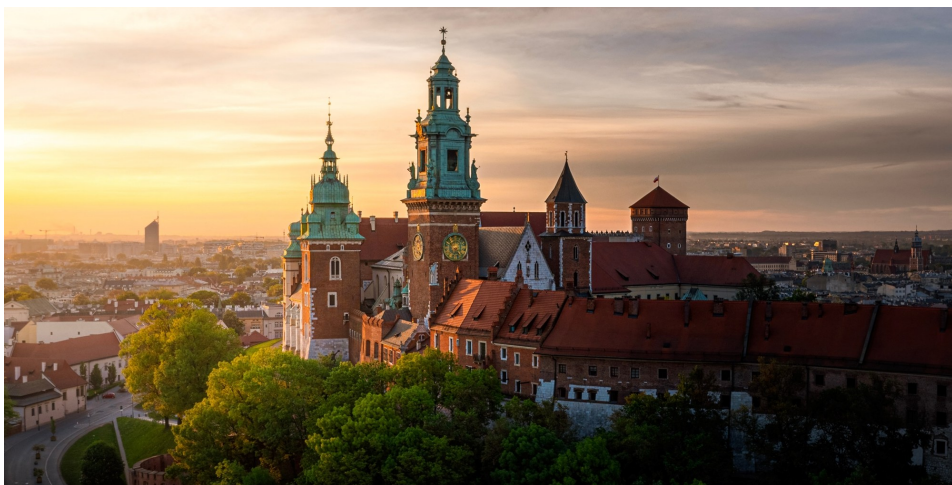




“We are Germany and Poland bound.”

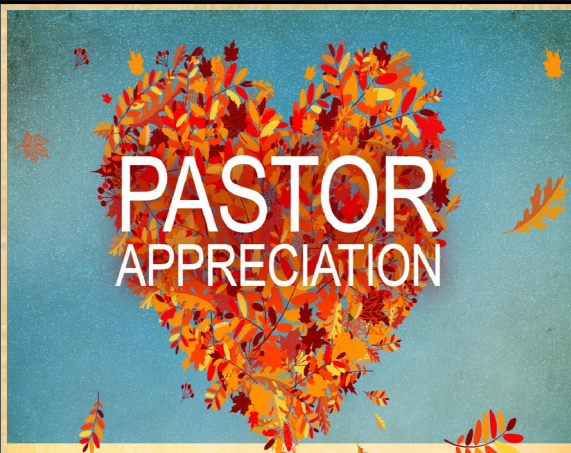

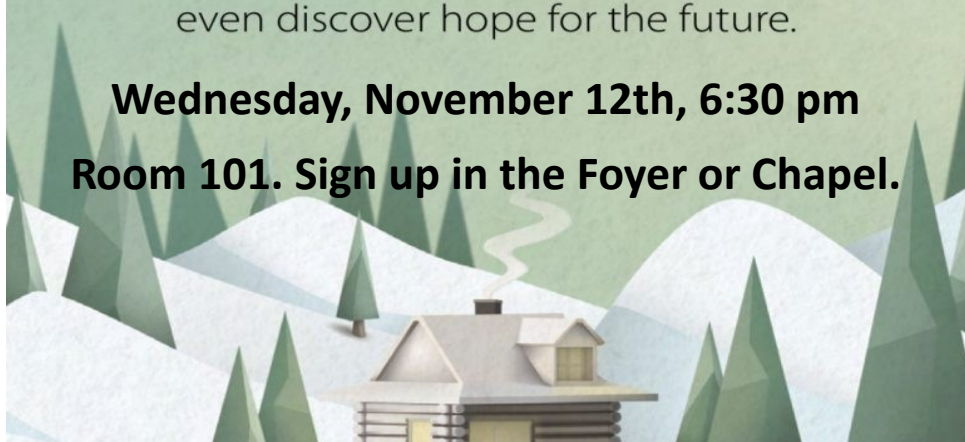
