

PRAYER PART 2: THE ASKING

This morning, we will take our second look at Paul and Timothy's prayer for the church at Colossae found in the first chapter of Colossians. In this portion of the prayer, Paul shares some specific petitions that he is asking God for on behalf of the church. Paul is interceding on their behalf to God. The term "intercede" means to plead or ask on behalf of another person, often to help them in a difficult situation or to resolve a conflict.

This is where we get the term "intercessory prayer." Interceding is one of the most loving and powerful thing that we can do for people in our lives. I look forward to walking through this text this morning, and we will have the opportunity to put this prayer into practice tonight at church wide prayer at 6 pm in the Fellowship Hall.
