I am truly excited about this Easter week. Let's be praying, inviting, and preparing our hearts as we celebrate the greatest news in history: **Jesus is alive.**

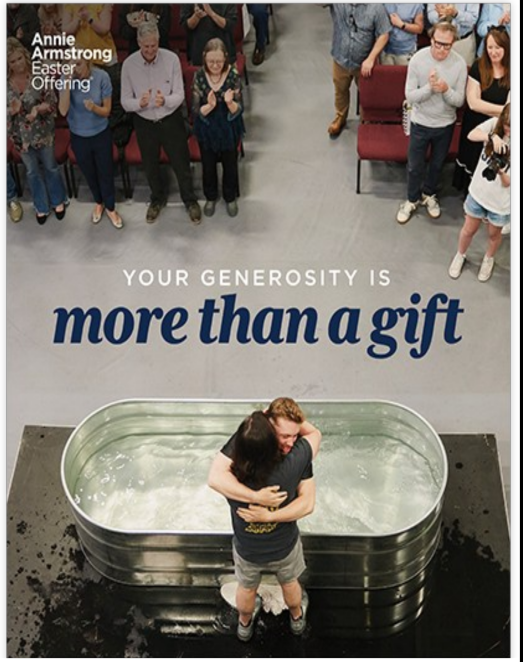
