DAY 2: KEEP ASKING

Read Matthew 7:7 Nlrv

Jesus said to ask, search, and knock. That means don't stop. Keep going. Keep praying. Prayer isn't about saying the perfect words. It's about trusting God enough to keep talking to Him. When you pray again and again, you are showing faith. You are saying, "God, I believe You hear me." Even when the answer is slow, God is working. God's kingdom grows in your heart as you learn to trust Him more.

DAY 3: PRAY ALL THE TIME

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:17 Nlrv

The Bible says to never stop praying. That doesn't mean you walk around with your eyes closed all day. It means stay connected to God. Talk to Him throughout your day. When something good happens, thank Him. When something hard happens, ask Him for help. When you feel confused, ask Him for wisdom. Prayer keeps your heart soft and strong at the same time.

DAY 4: FAITH THAT KEEPS GOING

Read Hebrews 11:1 Nlrv

Faith is being sure of what we hope for. It is being sure of what we do not see. Sometimes you pray, and nothing changes right away. That's when faith grows. You keep praying because you trust who God is. God isn't like the unfair judge in the Bible Story. He is loving. He listens. He cares. When you keep praying, you are living the greatest adventure. You are trusting God, the King, even when you can't see the whole plan. When you follow Jesus, you get to show God's Kingdom too. Every kind word, helpful choice, and loving action helps others see what God is like.

Preteen

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, let them know you are praying for them today. (You may even want to ask them if there is something they want you to pray about.)



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: “When have you prayed and seen God answer your prayer?”



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “When is a time you wanted to give up but kept going?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, thank You for always listening to us when we pray. Please help us to not give up even when you don't answer right away or answer in a way we might not want.”
