ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child’s room, cuddle them and say: “Good morning [child’s name]! I’m so happy to know that God forgives us and we can forgive others!”



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: “God, thank You for forgiving us. Help us to forgive like You.”



Drive Time

While on the go, talk about the different things we do. Say: “Whatever we do, we should put God’s kingdom first!”



Bath Time

Add some bubbles to bath time. Say, “Let’s put some bubbles on your head like a crown and say our memory verse. ‘Put God’s kingdom first’ Matthew 6:33.”
