DAY 2: FINGERPRINTS OF LOVE

Read 1 John 3:17

When a crime occurs, what do the police look for to solve the case? Evidence! Are there fingerprints at the scene? Is there a surveillance video that captured what happened? Were there witnesses who could give a good description of the suspect? The more evidence, the better chance they have of solving the case.

So how can the people around you see that you love and follow God? It's by your actions. Is there evidence of your love for God in the way you live? Do you see the needs around you and roll up your sleeves to help? Like a

fingerprint left behind to be discovered, is there evidence of your love? Are you making a difference not only to see a need but to help?

Think about one thing you did this week to show Jesus' love to others. Whose needs did you see and how did you meet them in a real way?

DAY 3: AT ALL TIMES

Read Proverbs 17:17

According to this verse, when does a friend love? That's right—at ALL times. When you feel like it and when you don't. When you think others will notice and pat you on the back and when no one else is around to see what you've done.

DAY 4: CONSIDER THIS

Read Hebrews 10:24

What does it mean to consider something? It means to think about it beforehand. It means to take some time on your own to wrap your mind around how you could help someone else, before you actually do the helping part.

For just a minute, think about one person in your world. What do they really need? How could you show love to help meet that need? How could you stir them to love and help? Set a timer and think. When you're finished, write down three things you could do to stir them to love.

Tonight, offer to help with dinner. As you stir the pot on the stove, or set the table, or whatever task your grown-up assigns, talk about your concentrated “thinking” time today. Tell them your plan and brainstorm some other ways you could help.

DAY 5: SHEPHERD AND THE SHEEP

Read Matthew 9:36

Sheep aren't very smart. Since they spend most of their time grazing, their heads are down most of the time, so they don't pay attention to where they're going. And because they'll blindly follow other sheep, if one of their buddies falls off a cliff, the others will soon follow right behind. Sheep don't have a built-in sense of direction like most animals. They lack that "homing instinct" that helps them get back to where they started from, so it's easy for them to get lost. So for a sheep, being without a shepherd is BAA-BAA-BAAD!

Jesus looked out at the crowds that day, they seemed to him like sheep without a shepherd. He was concerned for them. He healed them because He loved them. Did He ever get tired? Sure. Were there times when he needed or wanted to do something else? Probably. But Jesus still stopped to help and offer comfort. And He's asking us to show love and comfort to others, too.

“Jesus, we love you. Thank you for showing us how to love and care for others. When we see someone who’s hurting, help us to show our love and care. Amen.”
