This is what living like Jesus looks like!

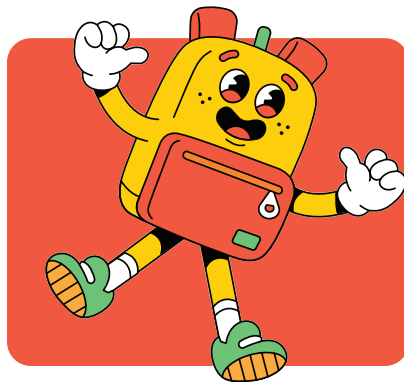
Day 3

Live like Jesus.

Living like Jesus. . . it could be the biggest challenge we ever take on! So the best thing we can do is to ask for help from Someone who also knows what it's like to put others first!

"Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to be my Savior and for showing me how to live. I want to live like Jesus, but it's hard to always put others first instead of what I need and what I want. Please give me wisdom on how I can do that and give me the humility to live like Jesus. In His Name, I pray. Amen."

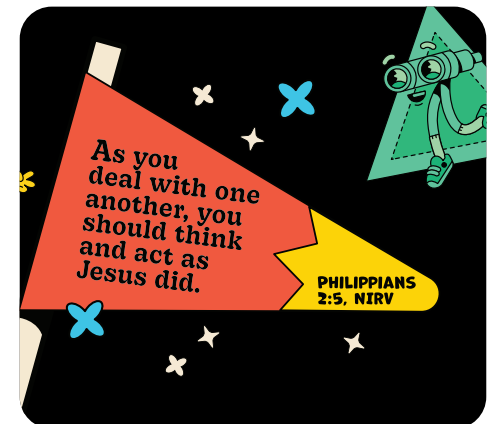

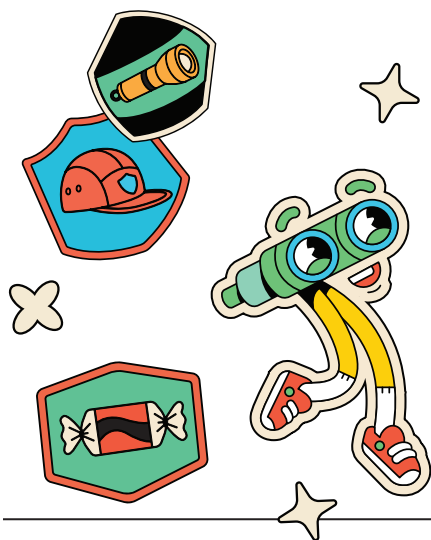
