## DAY 2: FORGIVEN PEOPLE FORGIVE

### Read Ephesians 4:32 NIV

The Bible tells us to forgive others just as God forgave us. That's a big deal. God doesn't forgive us halfway. He forgives us completely. When we remember how much God has forgiven us, it helps us forgive others. We may not feel like forgiving. We may still feel hurt. But forgiveness is a choice to trust God with what happened. God's kingdom looks different from the world. Instead of holding grudges, we show mercy.

## DAY 3: LET IT GO

### Read Colossians 3:13 NIV

Sometimes we want to hold onto anger. It feels powerful. But holding onto anger can actually trap us. Forgiveness doesn't mean what someone did was okay. It means you're choosing not to carry the anger anymore. You are letting God handle justice. When you forgive, you aren't just helping the other person. You are freeing your own heart.

## DAY 4: GOD REMOVES OUR DEBT

### Read Psalm 103:12 NIV

The Bible says God removes our sins as far as the east is from the west. That means He doesn't bring them up again. He doesn't keep a scorecard. When we forgive, we reflect what God has already done for us. Forgiveness grows peace in our hearts. And peace is part of God's kingdom. Forgiveness isn't always easy. But with the Holy Spirit's help, you can choose it.
