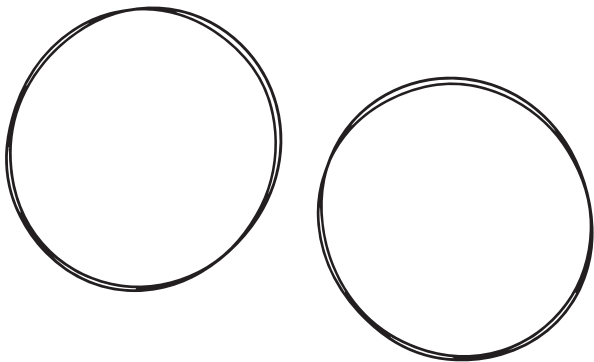
Read: Luke 18:1–8

DAY
1

Keep Praying

You can talk to God anytime. In the morning. At school. Before bed. Sometimes, God says, “Yes.” Sometimes, God says, “No.” And sometimes, answers take time. But God always, always listens to you when you pray.

God Hears Me

God is kind and loving. He is never too busy for you. When you pray again and again, He listens, every time. You can tell Him how you feel. You can ask Him for help. He cares about every worry and every joy. God always wants to hear from you.

3

Don't Give Up

Sometimes we pray and wait, and wait, and wait. Waiting can feel hard. But God knows what is best. Don't stop praying! When you keep praying, your faith grows stronger.

AT-HOME ACTIVITY: With a grown-up, make a short prayer list and put it by your bed. Pray for the same thing every day this week.

ASK God to help me keep praying.

DAY
4

Thank You for Listening

God loves when you talk to Him. You can pray and talk to God anywhere—at home, at school, on the bus, at the park. God hears you wherever you are! When you pray and don't give up, God's kingdom grows in you.

PRAYER ELEMENT: “Dear God, thank You for listening to me. Help me keep praying and trusting You. In Jesus' name. Amen.”

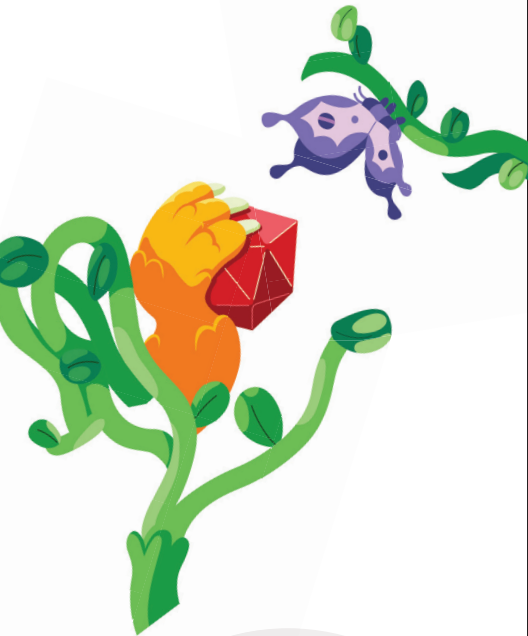

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER

Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, let them know you are praying for them today. (You may even want to ask them if there is something they want you to pray about.)

Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: “What do you pray about?”

Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “When is a time you wanted to give up but kept going?”

Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, help us to keep coming to You with our prayer requests and never give up.”
