Morning Time

Drive Time

While on the go, ask your child what they would want to write in a note to a friend or relative. Tell them that the Bible is like a letter to us, telling us about who God is and how much He loves us.



Bath Time

Bring two action figures or Little People and a large plastic bowl into the tub. Put the tub over the figures upside down so they are trapped inside. Talk about how Paul and Silas talked to God when they were in jail and, God freed Paul and Silas from jail.
