Read: John 3:16 NIV



DAY
1

GOD LOVED

Did you know that the God who made you and knows everything about you LOVES you very much? It's true. But God's love is even bigger than that. Because God loves you and everyone in the whole world.



Use a non-permanent marker (not a permanent one) to color your finger tip and then press it inside the rectangle above to add your fingerprints. Ask the people in your family to add their fingerprints too.

WE BELIEVE

When we put our trust in Jesus and believe that He died on the cross for our sins, we can have a relationship with God forever! God sent Jesus to show us just how much He loves us!

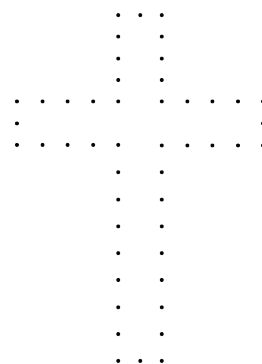
Have you put your trust in Jesus? Read this verse together with your grown-up and talk about what it means to trust Jesus with your whole heart.

LIFE FOREVER

When you understand just how much God loves you and decide to put your trust in Jesus as your Savior, you receive or have a relationship with God that lasts FOREVER! Forever is the most time ... ever. It's hard to imagine it, but it's true. That's how much God loves you.
