## DAY 2: WHAT KIND OF SOIL ARE YOU?

### Read Matthew 13:23 NIV

Jesus told a story about seeds and soil. The seed was the same in every place, but what changed was the soil. Some soil was hard. Some soil was rocky. Some soil was crowded with weeds. But the good soil lets the seed grow. Jesus explained that God's Word is like that seed. When we hear what God says and let it sink into our hearts, something amazing happens. It grows. It changes us. God's kingdom grows when we don't just hear His Word, but actually do what He says.

## DAY 3: ROOTS THAT GO DEEP

### Read Colossians 2:6-7 NIV

Rocky soil lets plants start growing fast. But when hard times come, the plants dry up because their roots are shallow. Following Jesus is exciting. But the real adventure happens when your roots grow deep. Deep roots grow when you pray, read the Bible, and trust God, even when life feels hard. When you stay connected to Jesus, your faith doesn't dry up. It grows stronger.

## DAY 4: WATCH OUT FOR WEEDS

### Read Matthew 6:33 NIV

Some seeds grew, but the weeds crowded them out. Jesus said worries and distractions can do that in our hearts. Worries about school. Worries about wanting more stuff. Worries about trying to fit in. Those things can take over our thoughts and push God to the side. But God's kingdom is the greatest treasure. When we choose to put God first, He helps everything else fall into place.
