Good News Travels Fast

Have you ever heard really exciting news and couldn't wait to tell someone? That's what it was like when people heard about Jesus! When God sent Jesus, it was the best news ever, and people wanted everyone to know.

Make a paper megaphone with a grown-up. Decorate it with stickers or colors. Use it to shout something good about Jesus, like "Jesus loves me!"

ASK God to help you share His good news in kind and joyful ways.

Joyful Song

Mary couldn't keep quiet when she heard God's plan about Jesus! She sang a happy song to God! Think of a time you danced or jumped up and down because something great happened. Christmas is God's good news for everyone. Jesus shows us that God keeps every promise, right on time. Take a moment to whisper "Thank You" to God. Those two words are very powerful.

You can even pray a simple prayer like this: "Dear God, thank You for Jesus and Your perfect plan."
