Read: Proverbs 4:26 NIV

King's Choices

Long, long ago, God's people had kings. Some kings, like David and Solomon, tried to make wise choices and follow God. But others made bad choices that led to trouble. One king, Rehoboam, listened to bad advice and made a very unwise choice that split the whole kingdom! Our choices, big or small, can really matter for ourselves and for others.

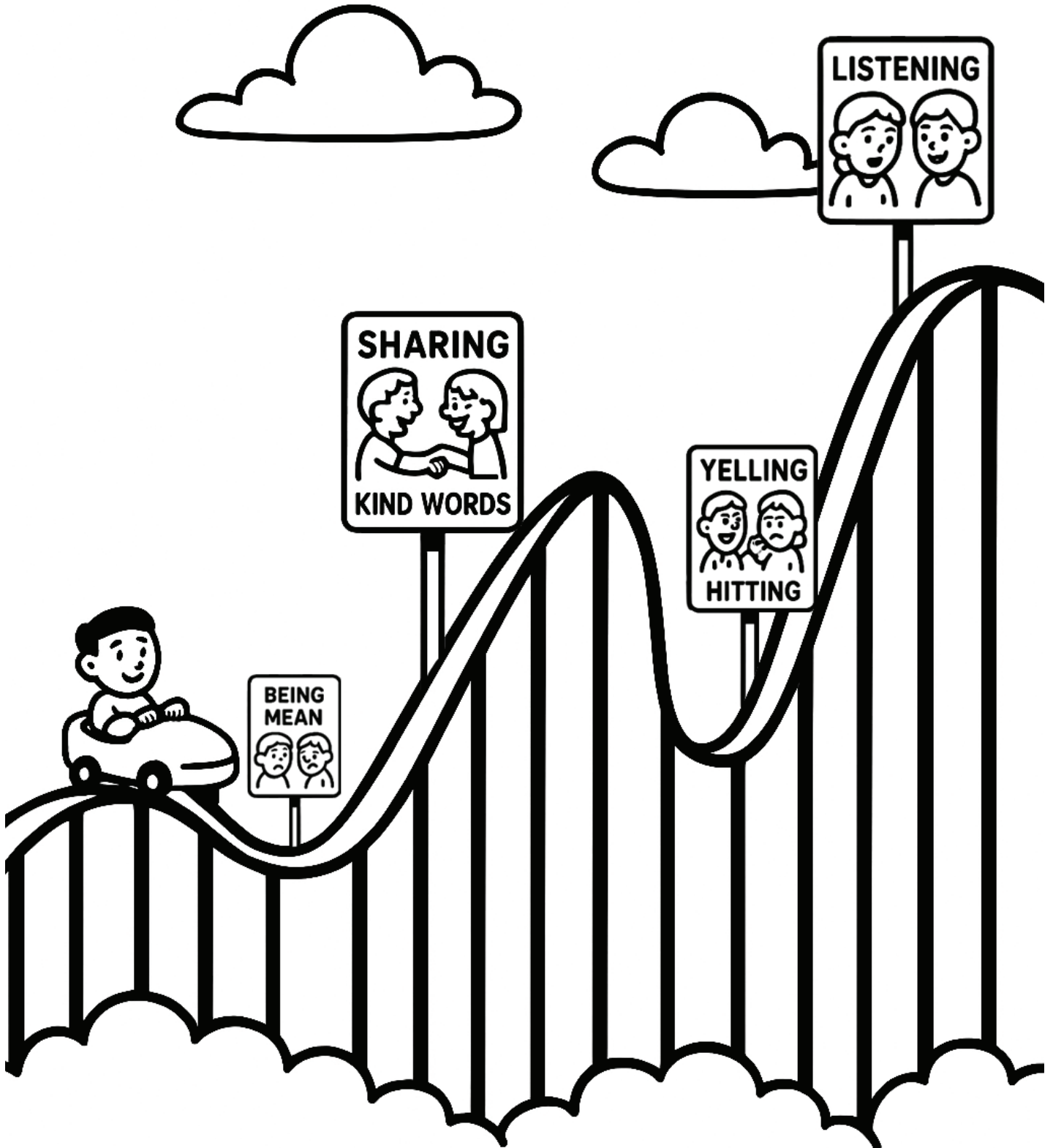
Jesus Shows Us

Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, remind your kid of a time they inspired you to make a good choice.



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "Why do your choices matter?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "What is a good choice you've seen someone make lately? What is a bad choice you've seen someone make lately?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, help us to focus on your wisdom from the Bible and choose what You think is best. Help us to learn to listen to the Holy Spirit whom You have placed in us, and make choices that honor You and others."
