ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning! I love you, and God loves you. God loves us so much He gave us Jesus!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, Christmas is a special time for people to give gifts to each other. Please help us remember that You already gave us the best gift when You gave us Jesus. Thank You for Jesus, God!"



Drive Time

While on the go, look for squares. Some presents are shaped like a square. At Christmas, we celebrate that God gave us Jesus. Jesus is the best gift ever!



Bath Time

Ask your child to help you decorate your bathroom for Christmas (garland, construction paper stars). During bath time, say: "Christmas is when we celebrate that God gave us Jesus. Decorations are one way we can celebrate Jesus. What are some other ways we can celebrate Jesus?"
