Yesterday, Today and Always

When you read stories about Jesus in the Bible, you'll see how He helped and served and loved every person He met. Jesus loves you just as much as ...

the blind man He healed.
the disciples who followed Him.

And because Jesus loves you THAT much, He deserves our time and attention. Talk with your adult about one thing you could do this week to show Jesus how much you love Him.


DAY

Make time for Jesus first.



ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "What are some ways you make time for Jesus every day/week?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "If you were planning out your week, what are some things you make time for?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "Jesus, show us how we can put You first every day. Remind us of how You want to be a part of all of our lives, not just at one particular time of the day."
