DAY 1 Read: Proverbs 3:5-6 NIrV

Trust in the Lord with all your heart

Sometimes we don't know what is going to happen next. And that's okay! God knows what is next! Proverbs 3:5 says to "trust in the Lord with all your heart." Look at the image below. 
Stretch your arms out straight in front of you like you're making a clear, straight path.
