1. His Domain: Lucifer was a gloriously created being and fell from heaven to the earth


“¹² “Son of man, take up a lamentation for the king of Tyre, and say to him, ‘Thus says the Lord GOD:

The 5 “I will” statements of Lucifer:


The 5 “I will” statements of Lucifer:

From the midst of the fiery stones.**


