1. Read the Revealed Reality of the Trinity in Scripture:

Three Persons, One God.

"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen." 2 Corinthians 13:14

"But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life." Jude 1:20-21



Justin Martyr records in the 2nd century how communion was carried out:

"Then bread and a cup of wine mixed with water are brought to the presiding brother. Taking them, he gives praise and glory to the Father of the universe through the name of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"


(Justin Martyr, First Apology, Chapter 65).



Polycarp, the leader of the Church in Smyrna and an early Christian martyr, prayed on the day of his death:

"Therefore, I also praise You for all things, I bless You, I glorify You, along with the everlasting and heavenly Jesus Christ, Your beloved Son, with whom, to You and the Holy Ghost, be glory both now and to all coming ages. Amen," (Martyrdom of Polycarp, Chapter 14).

The unique roles of the individual members of the Trinity:

- The Father appoints the plan of salvation. He is the architect of creation and is the ultimate source or cause of the universe (1 Cor. 8:6; Rev. 4:11), divine revelation (Rev. 1:1), salvation (John 3:16–17), and Jesus' works (John 5:17).
- The Son accomplishes redemption through His life, death, and resurrection and is the person through whom the Father creates and maintains the universe (John 1:3; Col. 1:16–17), gives divine revelation (John 1:1; Rev. 1:1), and saves (Matt. 1:21; 2 Cor. 5:21; Col.1:12-14). The Father does all these things through the Son.



The unique roles of the individual members of the Trinity:

• The Holy Spirit applies the work of salvation to believers, conforming them to the image of Jesus Christ by guiding and empowering them. He is the person by whom the Father creates and maintains the universe (Gen. 1:2; Job 26:13), gives divine revelation (John 16:12–15; 2 Peter 1:21), saves (John 3:6; Titus 3:5), and Jesus' works (Isa. 61:1; Acts 10:38). The Father does all these things by the power of the Holy Spirit.
