3 Features of the Messiah's Arrival in Jerusalem

1. Preparation: Arranging for Messiah's Entrance into Jerusalem.

Some of the signs that will occur before the Triumphant return of Christ:

- Wars, turmoil, and increase in wickedness—The Bible warns that there will be great turmoil, wickedness, war, and suffering on the earth.
- Signs of the moons and stars—Jesus tells about the incredible signs in the heavens before He comes.
- Natural disasters will be global and severe—There will be pandemics, flooding, fires, earthquakes, famines and meteor strikes on Earth.
- Charismatic and convincing false prophets will appear—They will be as charismatic as they are evil and will lead millions astray.

Some of the signs that will occur before the Triumphant return of Christ:


“And Jesus answered and said to them: “Take heed that no one deceives you. For many will come in My name, saying, ‘I am the Christ,’ and will deceive many. And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all *these things* must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. All these *are* the beginning of sorrows. Matthew 24:4-8

“Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. 


3 Features of the Messiah's Arrival in Jerusalem
