3 Questions in Jesus' last public invitation to Israel's leaders

1. Who is Jesus?

- · I told you, I will raise Myself from the dead (John 10:17-18).
- · I told you, I am the Bread of Life (John 6:48).
- · I told you, I am the Light of the World (John 8:12).
- · I told you, I am the Door (John 10:9).
- · I told you, I am the Good Shepherd (John 10:11).
