"The New Covenant-Part 4"

Hebrews 9:15-28



1. By virtue of <u>His sacrifice</u>, Jesus Christ has become the <u>Mediator</u> of the New Covenant (v.15)

"But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises." Hebrews 8:6

"For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time," 1 Timothy 2:5-6

"...to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than *that* of Abel." Hebrews 12:24

- 3. Because of Christ's once for all sacrifice for our sins, we can look forward to salvation when He returns, not to judgment. (v.23-28)
