3 Principles that help you to remain faithful to the Lord during trials

1. Abraham's Test: Understand that trials are a part of God's plan to grow our faith in Him (v.17a)



“Untested faith may be true faith, but it is sure to be small faith, and it is likely to remain little as long as it is without trials. Faith never prospers so well as when all things are against her: Tempests are her trainers, and bolts of lightning are her illuminators” -CH Spurgeon



Abraham had been tested a number of ways:

- **The Forsaking Test, when leaving Ur of the Chaldees to come to Canaan.**
- **The Famine Test, after arriving in Canaan.**
- **The Falsehood Test, in Egypt when he lied about Sarah.**
- **The Family Test, in regards to parting with Lot.**
- **The Fortune Test, in turning down the reward offer from the wicked king of Sodom.**
- **The Foremost Test, when he is asked to offer up his son, Isaac.**
