


We each have a specific course mapped out for us:


- -Some are straight, others many twists; some have flat land, others hilly; some low altitude, some high; all are long, some are longer.

- -Then we too can say as Paul, I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.








3 Important factors in running your race of faith




- 1. Run the race of faith by <u>casting off sin</u> and <u>persevering</u> in living for Jesus Christ just like those who have gone before you. (v.1)
- 2. Focus on Jesus who has joyfully run the race ahead of us and marked out our running lane for us. (v.2)
- 3. Take encouragement in your trials by <u>remembering the</u> <u>perseverance</u> of Jesus in the face of sinners. (v.3)
