3 Ways we can grow from Israel's past failures

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2. Israel desired evil things: But we must set our affections on the Lord to please Him with our lives.

**“Delight yourself also in the LORD,
And He shall give you the desires of your heart.” Psalm 37:4**

**“And you will seek Me and find Me,
when you search for Me with all your heart.” Jeremiah 29:13**

“Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.” Colossians 3:2

“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.” Romans 12:1-2
