3 Powerful insights about the betrayal of Jesus by Judas

1. The Betrayer Predicted:

Scripture is fulfilled in Jesus' betrayal.

(v.18-20)

“...and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed Him.” Mark 3:19

“But there are some of you who do not believe.

For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe,
and who would betray Him.” John 6:64

“Jesus answered them, “Did I Myself not choose you, the twelve,
and yet one of you is a devil?” Now He meant Judas *the son* of Simon
Iscariot, for he, one of the twelve, was going to betray Him.” John 6:70-71

“Then He took the twelve aside again and began to tell them the things
that would happen to Him: “Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem,
and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and to the scribes;
and they will condemn Him to death and deliver Him to the Gentiles;
and they will mock Him, and scourge Him, and spit on Him, and kill Him.
And the third day He will rise again.” Mark 10:32a-34

1. The Betrayer Predicted:

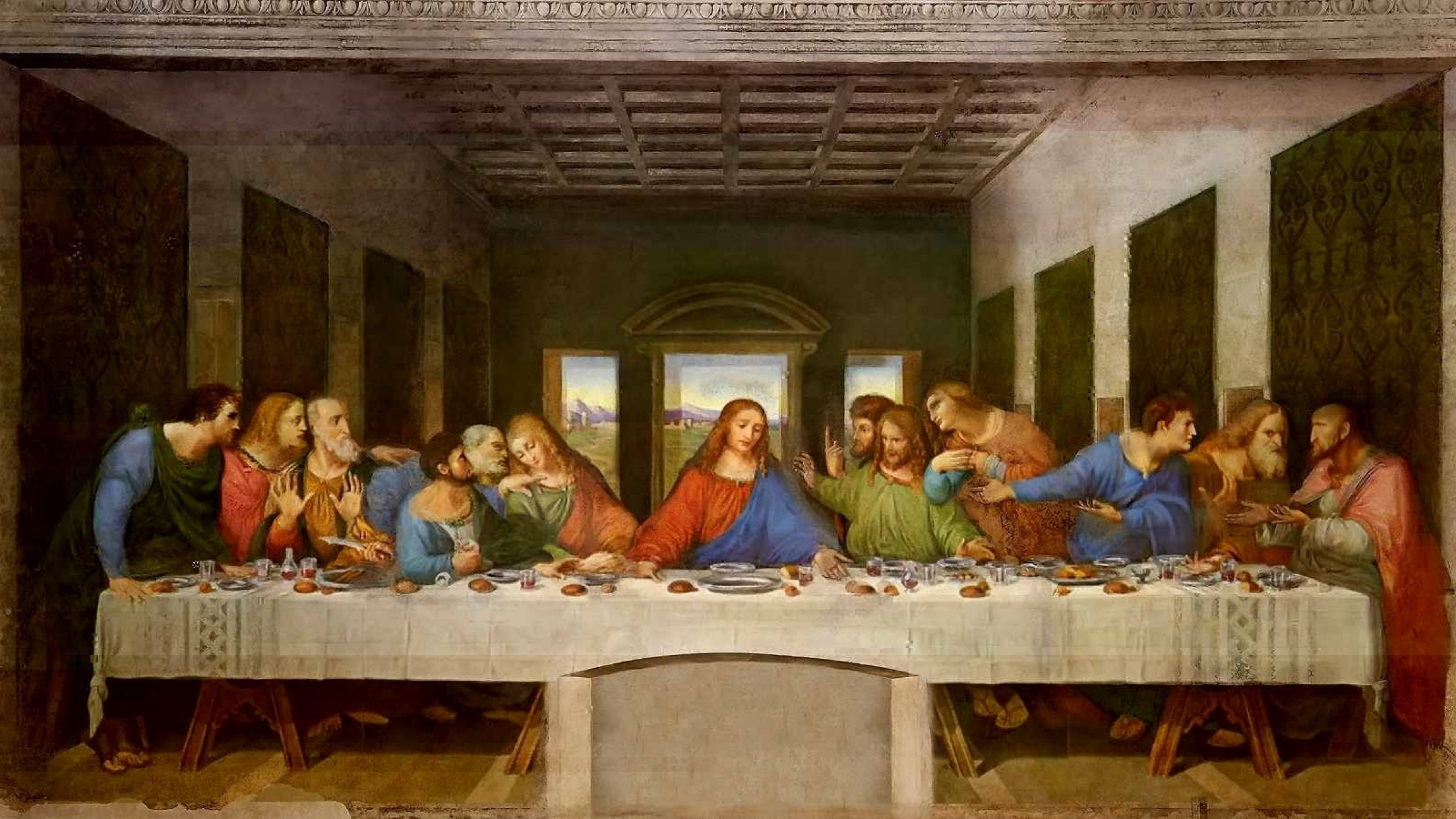
Scripture is fulfilled in Jesus' betrayal.

Jesus emotionally identifies Judas as His betrayer.

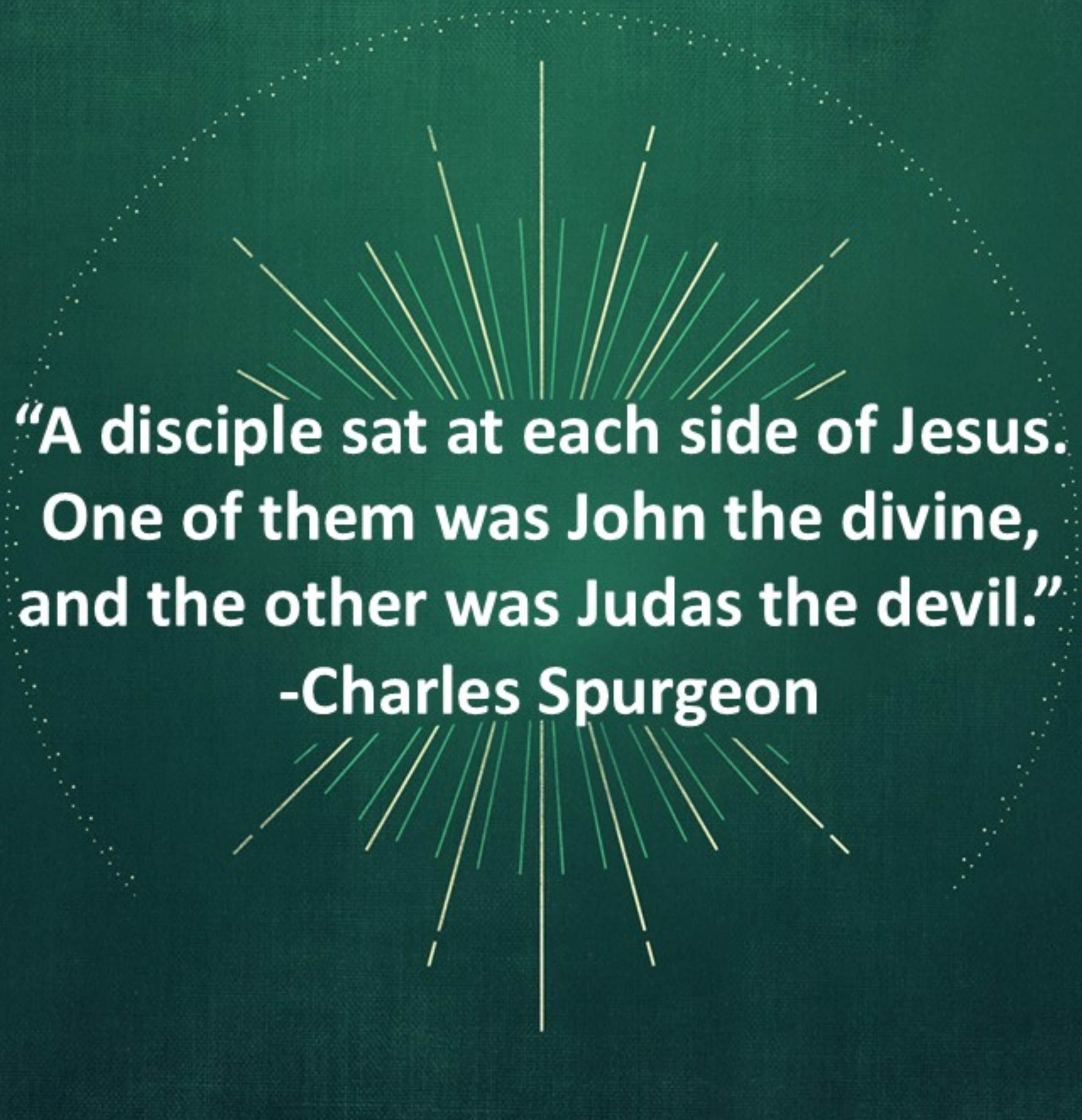
(v.21-26)

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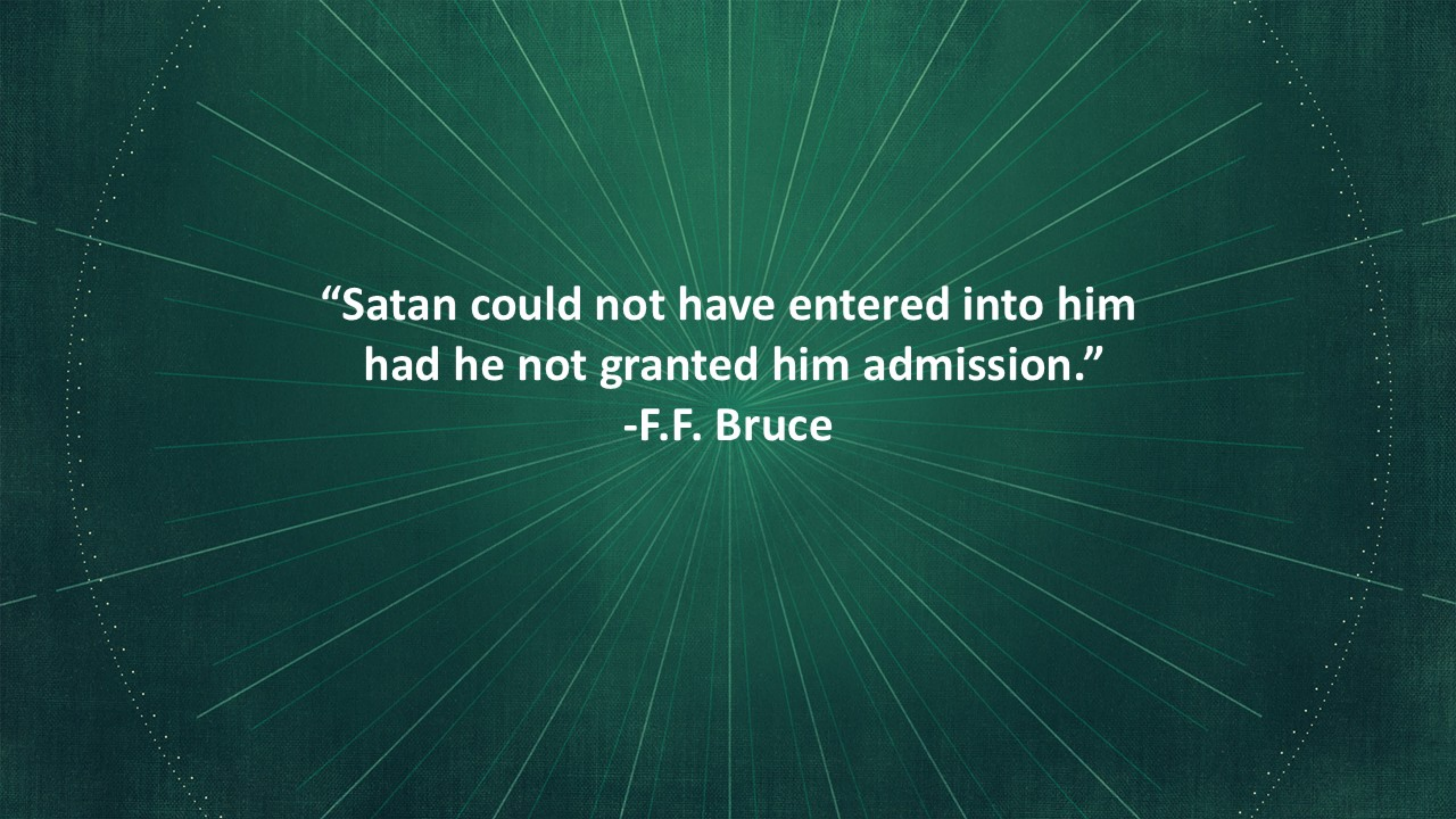

3. The Betrayer Possessed:

Satan takes residence within Judas in order to destroy Jesus.

(v.27-30)

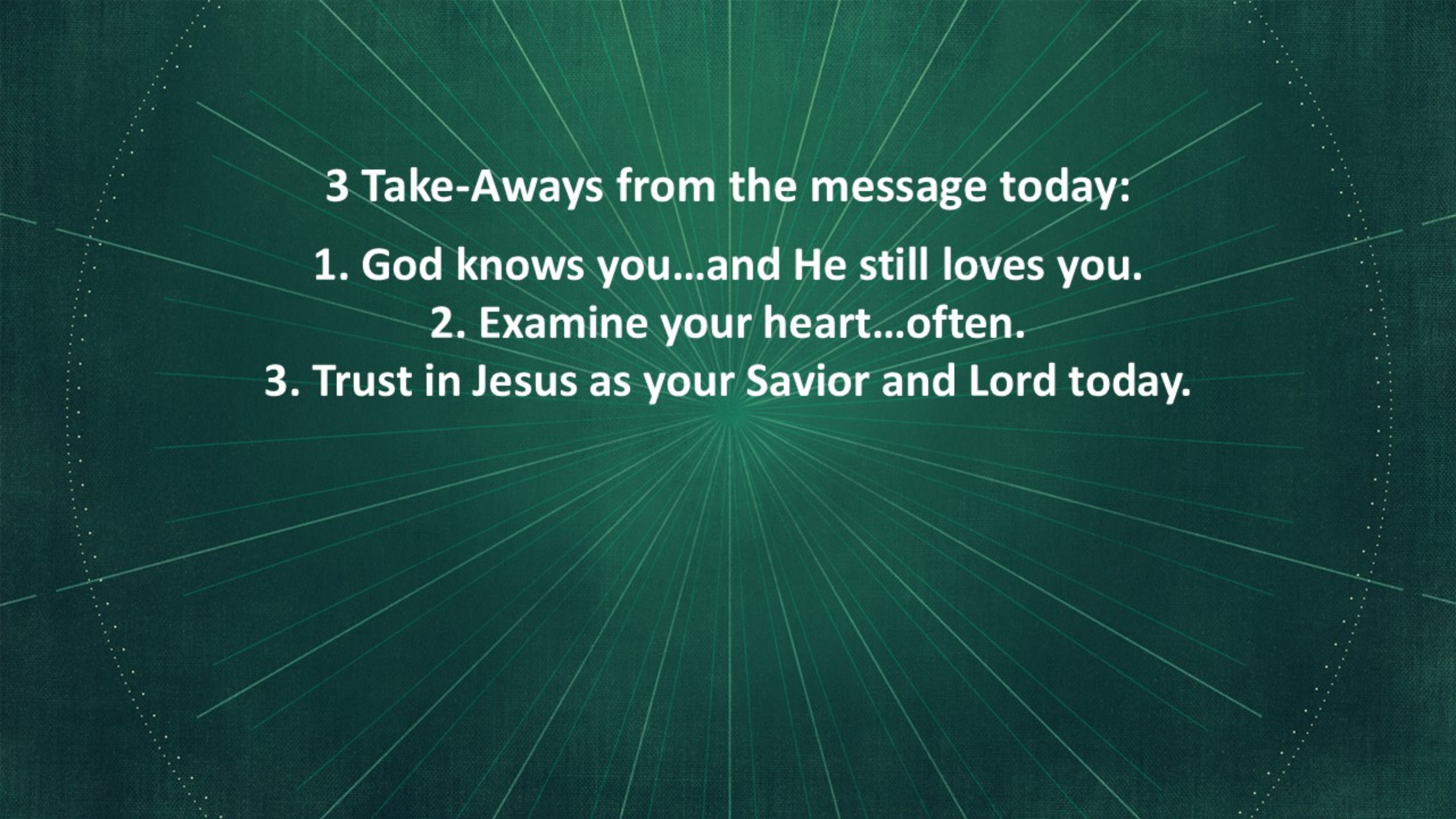


**“Satan could not have entered into him

How does Satan get a hold of someone's heart?

- An unsealed soul persists and progresses into greater levels of sin and depravity
- Opportunities to repent are met with resistance and hypocrisy
