Ruth 3:1-18

3 Scenes of redeeming love between Boaz and Ruth

1. **A Match-making Mother:** Seeking security for Ruth from Boaz as her kinsman-redeemer.

Kinsman-Redeemer (*goel*) had a specifically defined role in Israel's family life

- He was responsible to buy a fellow Israelite out of slavery (Lev. 25:48)
- He was responsible to be the “avenger of blood” to make sure the murderer of a family member answered to the crime (Num. 35:19)
- He was responsible to buy back family land that had been forfeited (Lev. 25:25)
- He was responsible to carry on the family name by marrying a childless widow (Deut. 25:5-10)

Principle: Trust the Lord and act in faith expecting good things from God.

3 Scenes of redeeming love between Boaz and Ruth

- 1. A Match-making Mother:** Seeking security for Ruth from Boaz as her kinsman-redeemer.
- 2. A Midnight Meeting:** Ruth lays at the feet of Boaz to ask for redemption and marriage.

Principle: Pursuing God-honoring ends requires God-honoring means.

3 Scenes of redeeming love between Boaz and Ruth

1. **A Match-making Mother:** Seeking security for Ruth from Boaz as her kinsman-redeemer.
2. **A Midnight Meeting:** Ruth lays at the feet of Boaz to ask for redemption and marriage.
3. **A Man on a Mission:** Boaz pledges to Ruth that he will redeem her.

**Principle: Honestly deal with your situation
and be hopeful about what God will do.**
