It is as if Paul was saying, “If you are one day going to sit in God’s supreme court over the world, aren’t you qualified to judge in the small, everyday matters that come up among you now?”



3 Helps in resolving disputes among believers in the church

2. Remember—as children of God, we are called to help resolve matters rightly between believers in the church. (v.2-8)
3. Realize that a Christian's identity and destiny is different than that of the unredeemed.(v.9-11)

- **You were washed: We are washed by the work of Jesus on the cross for us and by the Word of God.**
- **You were sanctified: We are set apart, away from the world and unto God, by the work of Jesus on the cross**
- **You were justified: We are declared “just” before the court of God by His grace**
