Ask that those in leadership positions would be given the wisdom and ability to address all that is looming on the home-front at this present time. Pray for grace to govern according to God's will, and that they may not be motivated by self-interest, greed or party politics, but rather may they be led to guide our state onto the path of peace and safety that only comes from the Lord.
