2. How have you seen God use an unexpected or painful circumstance in your life to open doors for His kingdom? (Philippians 1:12–13)
3. Who in your life has emboldened your faith through their endurance in suffering? How might your faithfulness strengthen others? (Philippians 1:14)
4. How does Paul's perspective challenge the way we respond to others who serve Christ imperfectly? (Philippians 1:15–18)
5. What does it look like for you to find joy in Christ's name being lifted up, even when circumstances or people frustrate you? (Philippians 1:18)
6. In what ways are you seeking to honor Christ in your daily life, relationships, and work? (Philippians 1:20)
7. If you were to honestly fill in the blank—"For me, to live is _____"—what would it be today? How does Christ reshape that answer? (Philippians 1:21)
8. How do you balance longing for eternity with Christ and faithfulness to your present calling here on earth? (Philippians 1:23–24)
9. What does a gospel-worthy life look like in your family, your workplace, and your community? (Philippians 1:27)
10. How does viewing suffering as a gift or privilege change the way you see hardships in your life? (Philippians 1:28–29)
11. How can your small group walk more faithfully together, striving side by side in the struggles of faith rather than facing them in isolation? (Philippians 1:30)
