2. Due to a situation imposed upon him, Abram pursued an overwhelmingly superior enemy. What was the outcome?
3. Abram returns home a victor with great spoils and is met by two kings. How did he act toward, respond to, and treat the King of Salem, Melchizedek?
4. How did Abram act toward, respond to, and treat the King of Sodom? Why did he treat the kings so differently?
5. What tests of character do you see Abram going through in Genesis 14?
6. Why did Abram give ten percent of the spoils to Melchizedek and return nearly all of Sodom's spoils to them?
