

Sermon Discussion Questions – Revelation 4

1. In Revelation 4:2–3, what details about the throne and the One seated on it stand out to you most, and why?
2. According to Revelation 4:1–2, why do you think John is shown the throne room of heaven at this point in the book, right after the messages to the seven churches?
3. What do the twenty-four elders and four living creatures in Revelation 4:4–8 reveal about order, authority, and worship in heaven?
4. How does the constant worship described in Revelation 4:8 challenge or reshape our understanding of worship in everyday life?
5. In Revelation 4:5, what do the lightning, thunder, and seven torches of fire communicate about God’s presence and activity?
6. What reasons for worship are given in Revelation 4:9–11, and how are they rooted in who God is rather than what He gives?
7. Why do the elders fall down and cast their crowns before the throne in Revelation 4:10, and what might that symbolize for us today?
8. How does the vision of heaven in Revelation 4:4–8 help us interpret chaos, suffering, or uncertainty in our lives now?
9. What does it mean that God is called “worthy” in Revelation 4:11, and how does creation factor into that declaration?
10. After reading Revelation 4 as a whole, how should this vision shape the way we respond to God in humility, trust, and worship?
