

**Sermon Discussion Questions**  
**Psalm 24 | The King of Glory**

1. Opening Question: What is your favorite place in nature to experience God's creation? What characteristics of God does it bring to mind?
2. Read Psalm 24.
3. Psalm 24 begins by declaring that the earth and everything in it belongs to the Lord. How does that foundational truth shape the way you view your daily work, relationships, or possessions?
4. Romans 1 says humanity has exchanged truth for a lie. What are some "false things" that people today tend to lift up their souls to? Are there any that you personally struggle to let go of?
5. Verse 4 says the one who can stand before God must have "clean hands and a pure heart." How do you react to that standard?
6. What does Jesus' ascension mean for you personally? Which of the sermon's applications (e.g., advocacy, sending the Spirit, being present everywhere) struck you most?
7. The sermon concluded by saying that Jesus "went first" so we could be sure of our place in heaven. How does that promise encourage you today, especially in the face of fear, suffering, or uncertainty?
